ENROLLMENT HEAVY AT HARBOR JC

Forty percent of the regular day students at Harbor Junior College are graduates of Harbor area high schools according to a report released today by Mrs. Hazel M. Whedon, administrative dean of the college.

Of the total of 1207 regular day students, 466 are graduates of either San Pedro, Banning, or Narbonne High School, San Pedro High School, with a total of 244 graduates enrolled, topped the list, followed by Banning High School with 129 graduates and Narbonne High with 93 graduates.

In addition, 90 HJC students are from other Los Angeles City High Schools, 539 from other California high schools, and 112 are from high schools in other states.

Total enrollment in classes offered by the local college is 3239, including the 1207 regular day students and an additional 2032 students enrolled in late afternoon and evening classes.

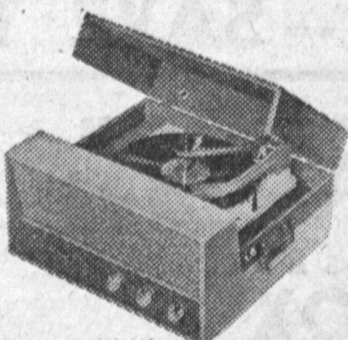
Our annual street rally will

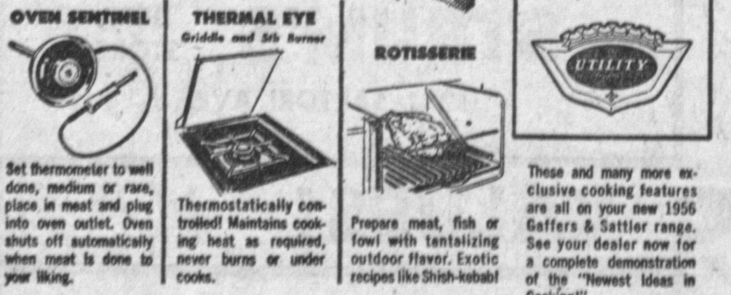
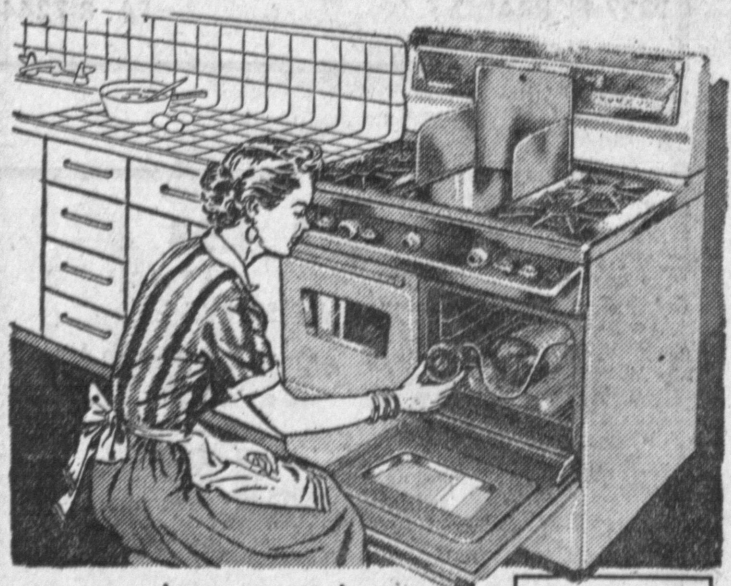

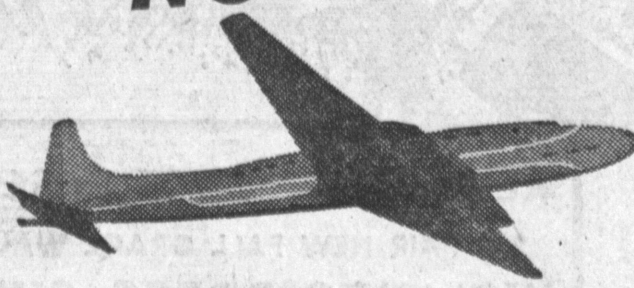
Boston Store Has Opening In Hawthorne

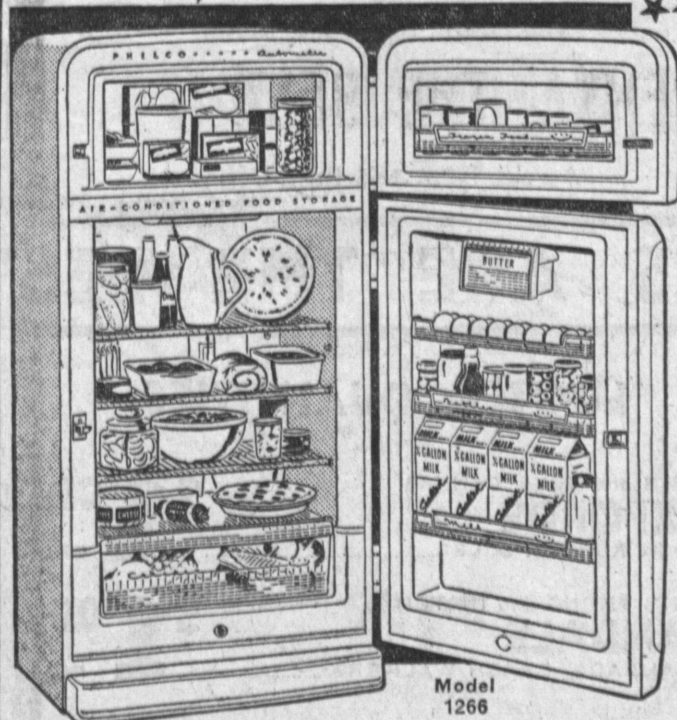

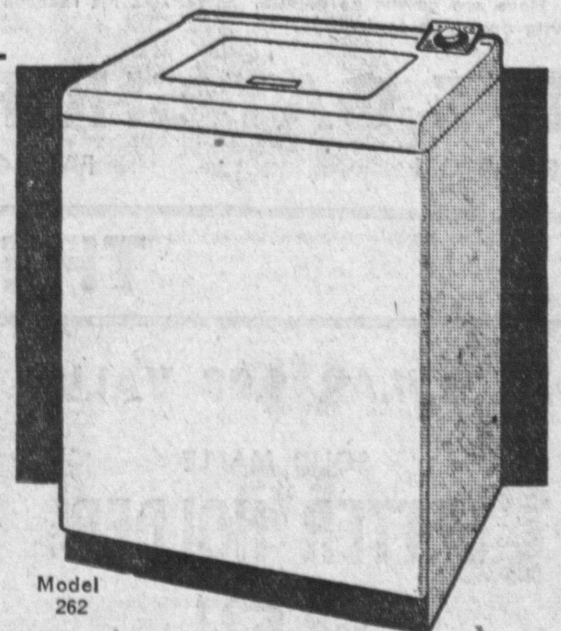
