USE OLD TEETH FOR NEW PLATES

Question—

"I have worn dentures for years. Because of gum shrinkage they don't fit any more. I like the way the teeth look; so can they be used in a new plate?" . . . asks Mrs. J. K. of Torrance

Answer—

Yes, the old teeth from your denture can be used in a new plate and can be used in such a way as to save you one-half the cost of a new plate.

The technique is this: A brand new impression is taken of the mouth and the old teeth are cut off the old plate and re-set exactly as they were onto the new plate. This works out wonderfully well where a new bite is not required. Completely brand new plastic is used throughout and the finished product is a brand new denture except for the fact that the teeth from the former plate are used.

Olympic Water Polo Team To Play Life Guards Here

The Surf Life Saving Team Fund is proceeding very satisfactorily, according to the fund-raising committee, with approximately \$650 turned in to date. Torrance's quota is \$1000, to help send a ten man team to represent

the United States at the Australian Surf Life Saving Carnival in Melbourne, Australia.

The match between the United States Olympic water polo team and the Los Angeles County Life Guard water polo team will take place Sunday evening, November 4, at 7 p.m., at the new Victor E. Benstead plunje, 3331 Torrance boulevard, at Madrona.

The United States Olympic Water Polo Team is the greatest that has ever represented the United States, being composed of players selected from the top players of all the water polo

teams in Southern California, officials said.

The Olympic team is as follows: Robert Horn, goalie; William Ross, guard; Robert Frojen, guard; Ron Severa, forward; Waly Wolf, center back; Robert Hughes center forward.

Alternates: Kenneth Hahn, center back; Don Good, forward; Bill Kooistra, forward; Sam Kooistra, center forward; Coach—Dr. Nell Kohlase.

Waly Wolf was a member of the 1952 Olympic swimming team. Robert Hughes was a member of the 1952 Olympic water polo team and also won the conventional breast stroke event on the United States Olympic swimming team.

Horn, Ross, Frojen, Wolf, and Hughes were 1954 members of the Pan-American Olympic

water polo championship. Ron Severa is a local boy, and is a life guard at Torrance beach.

The Los Angeles County Life Guard water polo team is as follows: Larry Cocke, of Torrance, goalie; Jim Norris, guard; participated in the 1952 Olympics; Dwaine McIlroy, guard; Chick McIlroy, center forward; Paul McIlroy, center back; Bob Burnside, forward; Robert Boardway, forward. Alternates: Dick Joy and John Calderwood.

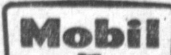
The County Life Guard team won the Summer Water Polo League. All the players on this team were in the Olympic try-outs. Dwight Crum, captain of the Lifeguards, Los Angeles County Lifeguard Service, at Hermosa headquarters, will emcee the program.

There will also be life saving stunts, and life saving exhibition demonstrating the lifesaving equipment.

The Surf Life Saving Carnival will be held in conjunction with the Olympic Games and will consist of international competition for surf life saving. Other countries competing include

England, Ceylon, South Africa, Australia, Hawaii, New Zealand. The Carnival will be held in Melbourne, Australia, November 25 through December 2, 1956.

Local boys will carry the name of the town that sent them on the uniforms that they will use while in competition.

CAMPFIRE GIRLS

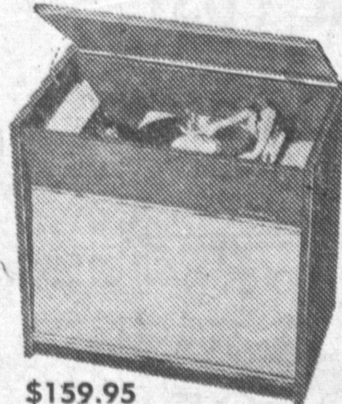

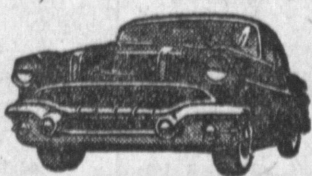

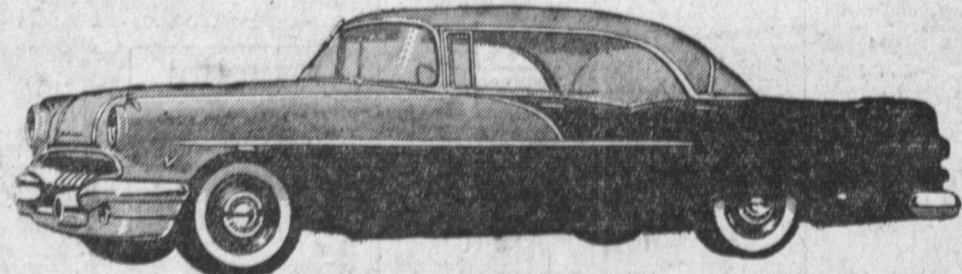
