### '57 License Plates Will Be Reflectors

Your California vehicle registration will be renewed for next year by attachment of a reflectorized red sticker, marked for 1957, to your rear license plate.

Paul Mason, state director of motor vehicles, said the stickers will replace the metal tab issued in former years as a renewal token. They are red in color, with black letters and numerals reading, "California, 1957," and are 1 1/2 by 1 1/2 inches in size.

"The motoring public will find several advantages in this device," Mason said. "They are easier to attach to the rear license plate than the metal tabs. They reflect light, thus adding a new visibility point to the rear end of the vehicle and adding a safety factor in night driving. Finally, they cannot be removed from a license plate without being destroyed or mutilated, thus adding a protection against theft or fraud, or evasion of the law by illegal transfer."

The renewal period dates are from January 2 through February 4, 1957. A small number of motorists who purchase vehicles after December 1, 1956, will be required under the law to register for the full year of 1957, and will receive their '57 certificates and sticker upon registration.

Cities which are runners-up to Torrance include Santa Monica, 79,883; Compton, 65,657; Inglewood, 58,146.
