

**400 PTA MEMBERS ATTEND  
223rd STREET SCHOOL MEET**

Approximately 400 parents and friends attended the "Back-to-School" PTA meeting at the 223rd St. school, Tuesday, November 13.

Held during American Education Week, the meeting precluded the dedication of 223rd St. school, scheduled for January 8.

Elizabeth Danky, principal, praised the parents for their interest in seeing what their 935 sons and daughters are accomplishing. The meeting also gave the parents an opportunity to meet the faculty and to more fully understand the school program.

During the informal conversation period, parents and the faculty exchanged individual progress reports.

According to summarized reports from the teachers on problems in the school, emphasis was placed on the many reading difficulties that students encounter. Parents were asked to help the school in developing the full potential within their children by challenging them to higher reading standards.

Reading aloud, reading games, and remedial reading aids were recommended as a means of dealing with the problem and aiding in the enrichment of a phonetical background.

It was concluded that discipline is the teachers number one problem and is being solved by a well planned day, with seat work, charts, and other materials ready before students arrive. A sense of humor, a controlled and poised manner also help solve this problem.

were tea chairmen. They were assisted by the room mother representatives.

Mrs. David P. Goolsby, president, presided over the brief business session, prior to the meetings which were held simultaneously in each child's room from 7:30 - 8:30 p.m.

Cubmaster Louis Funk of Pack 228C led the pledge of allegiance. Food for thought was given by Phillip Danky.

Barbara Ferrara's second graders won the prize for the largest attendance in the lower division, and Dorothy Armstrong's fourth graders won for the upper division.

Proceeds from the luncheon are going entirely for child welfare.



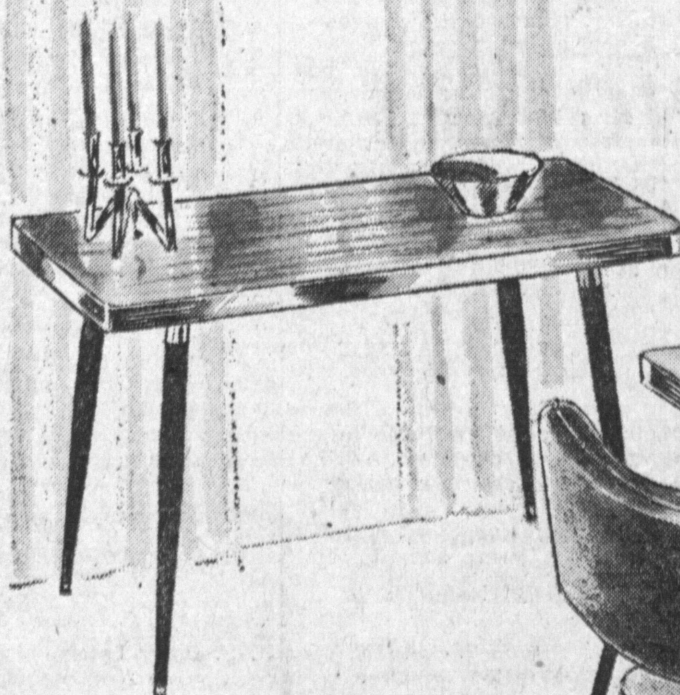

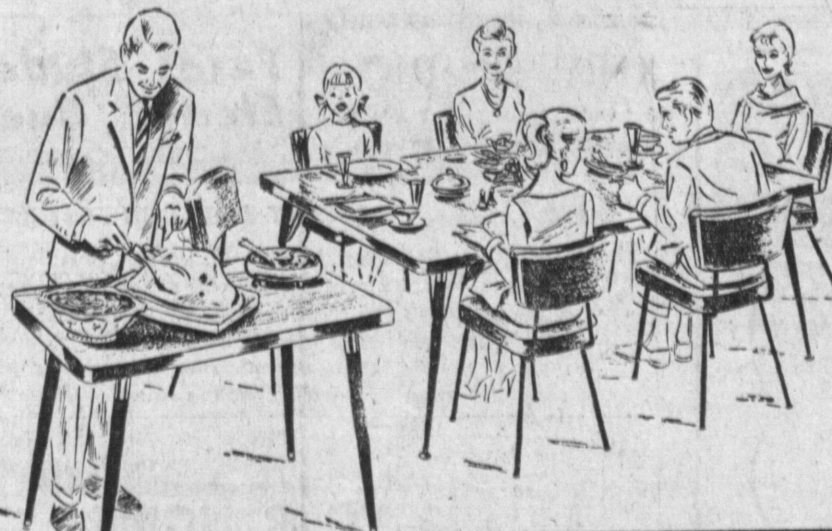
