North High PTA Meets

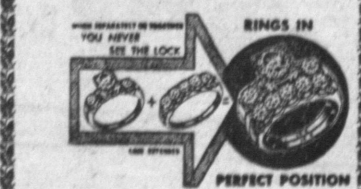

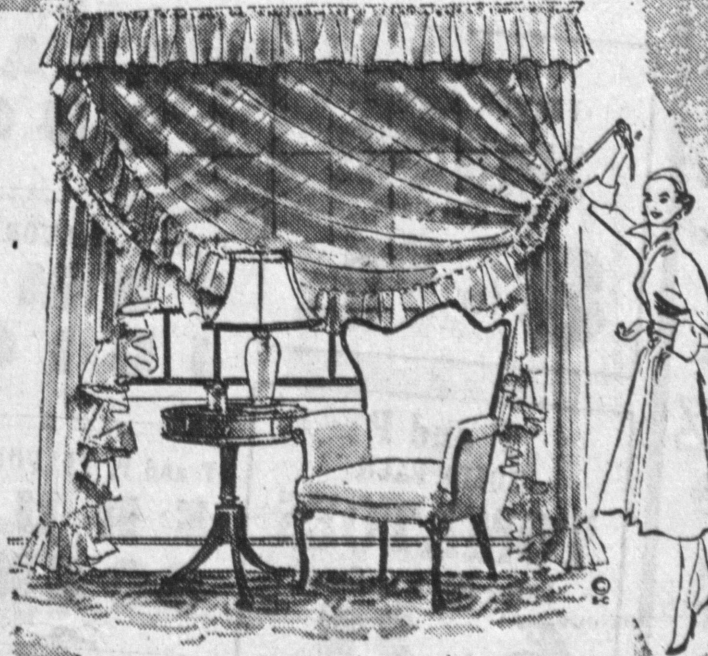
