Little League To Parade On Saturday

On reaching Cabrillo they will follow it to Del Amo blvd. to the Little League field where the opening ceremonies will take place under the direction of Robert Sonju, president of the National Little League.

All six teams in uniform together with their sponsors will be there to add color to the ceremony. Mayor Albert Isen and several other city officials such as the acting Chief of Police Percy Bennett and Fire Chief J. Jay Benner will be present.

The opening game will start at 3 p.m. between the Yankees, managed by William Turrentine and the Stars, managed by Al Whelan. All friends of little league are urged to attend. Admission is free.

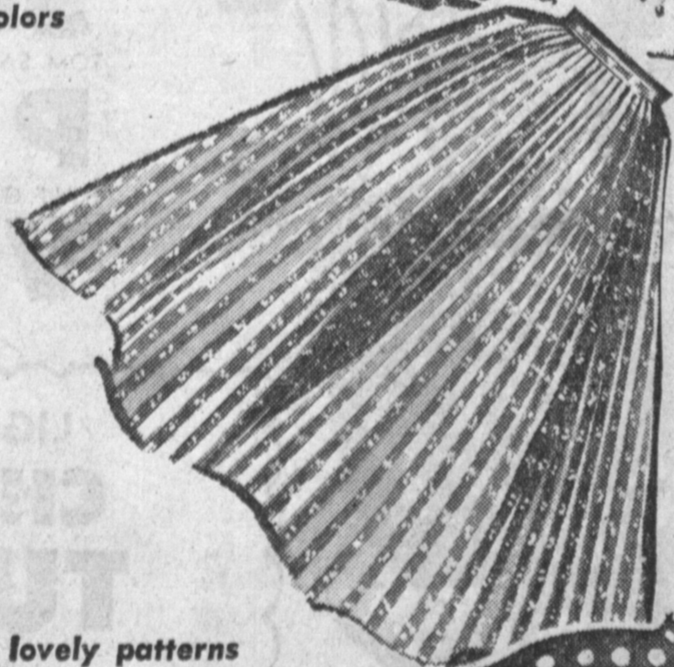

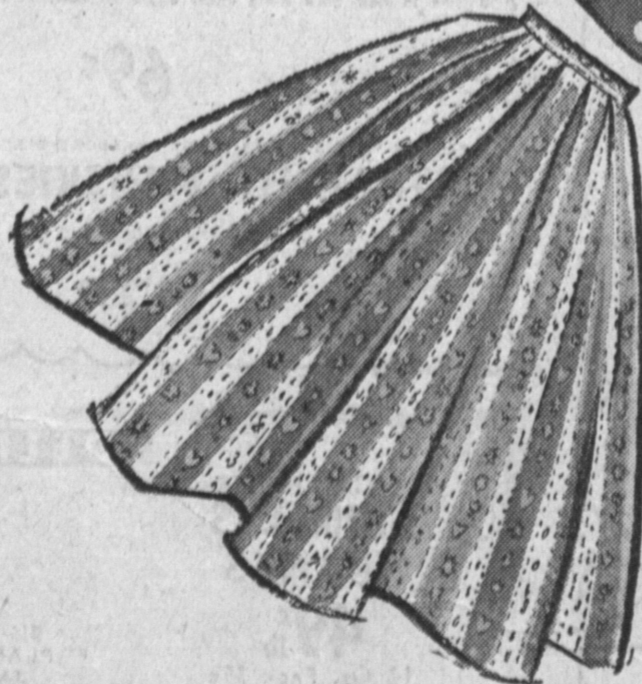
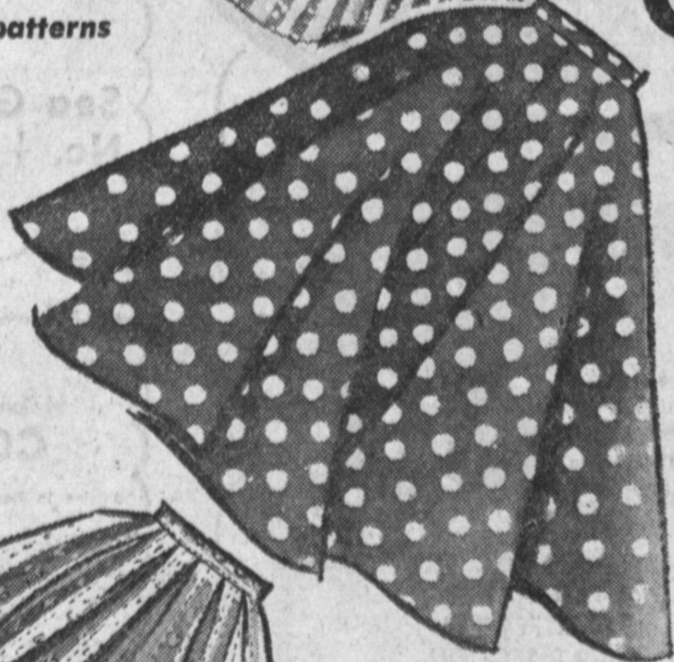
