The industrial and oil well operation in the northwest may delay housing for some time but ultimately this may become multiple dwelling units. At present, the population is concentrated in the northeastern sec-

Madrona elementary school and its play area is now serving this community.

Recommendations include:

1. A two to three-acre play area for children to be provided by the shopping center. 2. Location of a small branch

library in the shopping center. This has proved a particularly useful location in other cities. 3. A second choice site for the

fair park grounds is 50 acres of the southeastern tract (now zoned for industry but largely open area and oil wells). This would reduce the probably multiple dwelling units for this sector. First recommendation is at the corner of Crenshaw and Monterey. 50-Acre Fair Ground

Community neighborhood number 14 is bounded by Sepulveda, Crenshaw, Torrance and Maple.

A 50-acre major park and fair ground site, located at Crenshaw and Monterey, is recommended for this area. This would place the fair grounds in a central location and place a major park area in the "old East Torrance" area, the report proposed.

The northern part of this community above Carson has new single unit housing. At present there is Fern-Greenwood school and one small church playground.

It appears likely that the oil field area will give way to housing developments south of Carson, the report says. It is now zoned for industrial use.


