

Business, Industry Leaders To Organize Study Group

Torrance business and industry leaders will meet at noon Tuesday, July 23 at the Villa Capri, 2700 W. Redondo Beach Blvd., for the purpose of organizing an economic study group, it was announced today by Chamber of Commerce president, A. E. Thompson.

Harry A. Lintz, district manager of the California District of the Chamber of Commerce of the United States will be the featured speaker at the function designed to encourage world businessmen to understand more fully and to better defend our free enterprise system.

Before his employment with the National Chamber on 1946, Mr. Lintz spent twenty-three years in Public Administration. He holds two degrees from the University of Southern California.

a cystoscopy room and a cast room for fracture cases.

There is a large recovery room for the care of post-operative patients. There are three full time well-qualified anesthetists.

Obstetrical Suite

The obstetrical suite has a large delivery room, an emergency delivery room, labor rooms, and two large nurseries equipped with stainless steel and plastic bassinets.

Babies can be viewed through large windows inside the hospital and also from an outside window especially set up so that brothers and sisters under 16 years old can see the new-born babies even if they are not allowed inside the hospital.

There are complete clinical laboratory and X-Ray facilities on the premises, with adequate facilities for out-patients. Dr. John H. Woodruff is the radiologist and Dr. David B. Dickey is the pathologist.

A completely equipped pharmacy and a full time pharmacist are available.

The central supply suite comes completely equipped with two large sterilizers and water distilling apparatus. In addition, there are two high speed sterilizers in the surgical and obstetrical suites for emergency sterilization needs.

A complete sprinkler system to protect patients from fire hazards has been installed.

Doctors are provided with a large lounge with its own patio and medical library. A large doctor's register for accurate determination if the doctor is in the hospital and an intercom system are also available. Facilities for the doctor to spend the night if his patient needs him have been provided.

A cafeteria for doctors, employees and the general public and a number of other modern conveniences are available.

The present hospital contains 33,000 sq. ft., with all rooms being on ground level. There is enough area to add three more wings, at 30 beds a wing. The hospital will remain single story.

Background

48-FOOT CARRIER AT FAIR

A huge 48-foot replica of an Essex-class aircraft carrier will be on display on the Civic Center grounds as a highlight of Torrance's First Annual "Ranchero Days" July 24-28, it was announced today by President A. E. Thompson, of the Chamber of Commerce.

The "U.S.S. Recruiter" is a 1-20th size replica of the famed carrier class and was built at Naval Air Station, San Diego and was launched on Navy Day, October 27, 1947.

She is complete in all details having her own generators and compressors and is completely self propelled. Her compressed air catapult will actually launch flight models from the flight deck.

Mounted on a five ton chassis the "U.S.S. Recruiter" weighs 15,000 pounds and is 13 feet, eight inches high and 10 feet, six inches wide.

Thompson added that, because of the heavy demands for scheduling of the beautiful ship she will be on display on the fairgrounds on Wednesday and Thursday evenings, July 24 and 25.

TENNIS LESSONS OFFERED

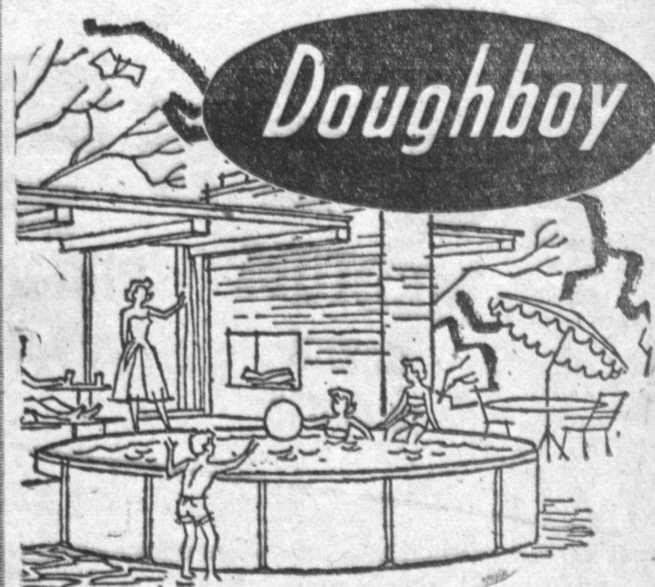
