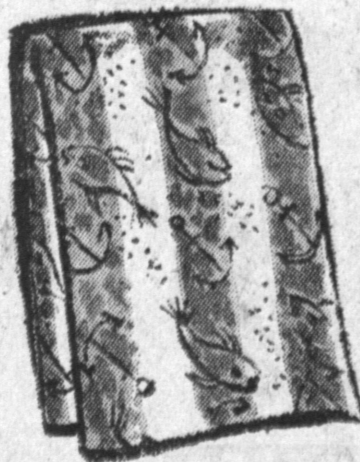

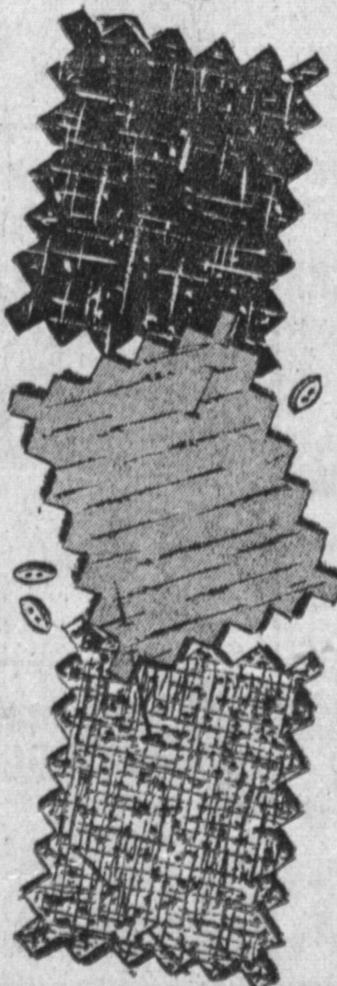
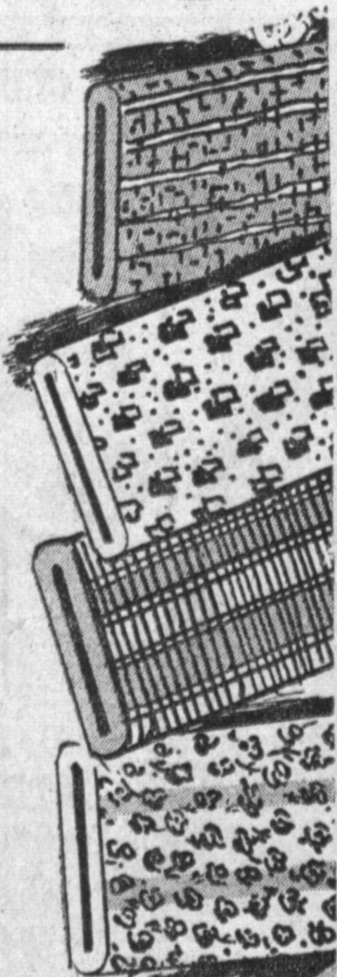

Seventh-Day Adventists Sponsor Summer Camps

Torrance young people will join 750 other Southland youth in a series of summer camps sponsored by the Seventh-day Adventist church at its Cedar Falls campsite in the San Bernardino mountains. The five camps, each lasting from seven to ten days, began Sunday, July 7, and will continue through Sunday, August 21. In addition to the coed camp for the 9-year olds, separate boys and girls camps will be held for age groups 10 to 11 and 12 to 15. Each camp provides a packed schedule of sports, swimming, outpost camping, hiking, nature study, and crafts, according to Desmond T. Cummings, camp director and the Church's youth leader for Southern California. "While the young camper is exposed to the wonders of nature it is an opportune time to explain to him that these wonders are the direct result of God's creative power," explains Cummings. To effectively meet this objective, a few moments each morning of the camp are set aside for the outdoor worship period at which time each camp commits to memory a brief passage of scripture. The evening campfire period also enjoys a spiritual emphasis. Cummings is confident that the church's summer camp program has a special role to play in the life of today's teenager from the metropolitan and suburban areas. He is convinced that the good camper of today will be the solid citizen of tomorrow. Cummings, himself a former teenage camper, is no doubt a living testimony to that result.

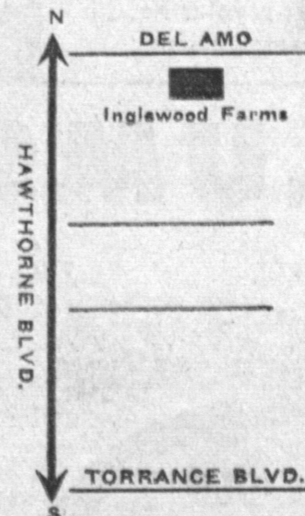
