"If you are disabled when you On the roll call on the motion pay you to file a compensation request within one year from the date of your discharge."

She explained that, if the Veterans Administration approves a veteran's compensation request within the first year, payments can be made retroactive -dated all the way back to his first day as a civilian.

But if an ex-serviceman waits beyond a year from date of disharge to apply, the best the VA can do is start payments from the date, of the applica-

Mrs. Evans reiterated that any veteran, old or new, may be entitled to regular monthly compensation payments for injuries or ailments which were incurred in, traceable to, or aggravated by military service. The amount, of course, depends on how severe the disability

happens to be. It must be rated at least 10 per cent disabling for minimum compensation to be payable. Veterans who are 50 per cent or more disabled may draw ad-

ditional amounts for their de-

pendents.
