BOARD HOLDS FIRST MEETING

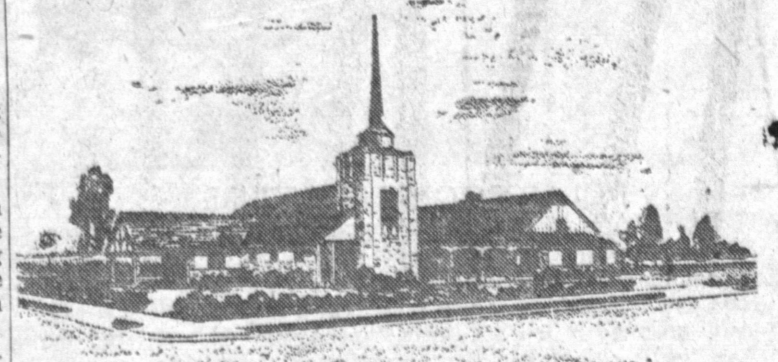
Arlington School PTA executive board held its first meeting for the fall season recently at the home of Mrs. Jack Prince, president, with 15 members in attendance.
