Contestants and participants in this water carnival are selected from all of the parks and playgrounds participating in the summer vacation program. This gives the children all over Torrance a chance to compete in various water events.

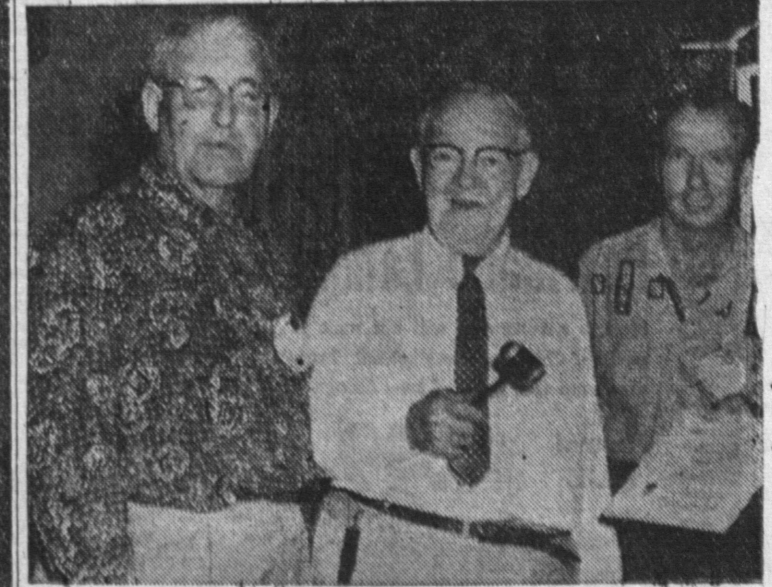
The general rules for contestants are as follows:
1. Each contestant is limited to 3 events.
2. Ribbons will be given to individual places in the event.
3. The area scoring the most points will receive an award.

The events are selected on an age basis and are as follows:
Those who are 7 and 8 years of age will compete in a balloon game, running relay and paddle kick race; those 9 and 10 years of age will compete in a tube game, goat ball and an event not yet announced; 11 and 12 years old will participate in a tube game, goat ball and treasure hunt (diving); the 13 and 14 year olds will compete in a swim race (50 yards), treasure hunt and towel relay.

The prizes will include a trophy for the winning area, plaques for individual winners and ribbons for runner-ups.
