Speed Law Effective Sept. 11

A major change in the truck speed law effective September 11, should be reviewed by all truck operators, says the California highway patrol.

"The new speed law for trucks was passed by the 1957 state legislature and becomes a part of the California Vehicle Code in September," declared Patrol Commissioner E. R. Caldwell. "It reads as follows: 'Any motor truck or truck tractor having three or more axles or any motor truck or truck tractor with any trailer or semi-

trailer, or any combination thereof, shall not be driven on any highway at a speed in excess of 45 miles per hour. This section does not include any bus having three or more axles.'

"Analysis of 1956 data reveal that, of all commercial vehicle operators deemed at fault in traffic accidents in unincorporated areas, 28 per cent were in violation of speed laws," Caldwell stated. "The California highway patrol is beginning an extensive information program designed to bring this and other new laws to the attention of the general public.

"Full enforcement emphasis will be applied to the new truck speed law," he concluded.

Loop 24. Par will read: 2,3,3-3,3, 2-3,2,3. The two-pars will give the golfer a long approach of from 60 to 120 feet, depending on the location on the markers.

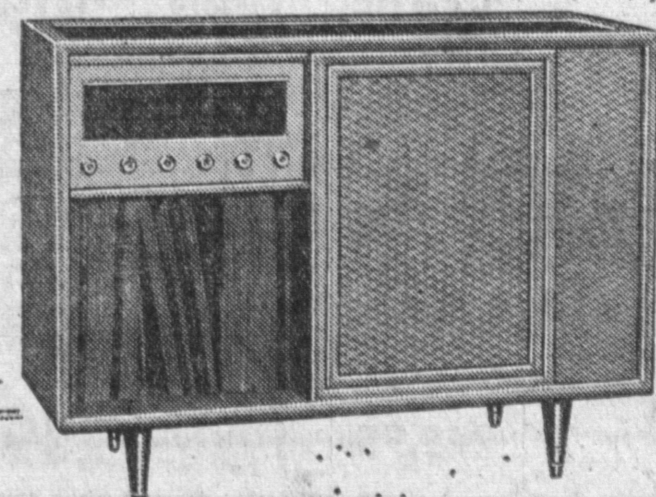

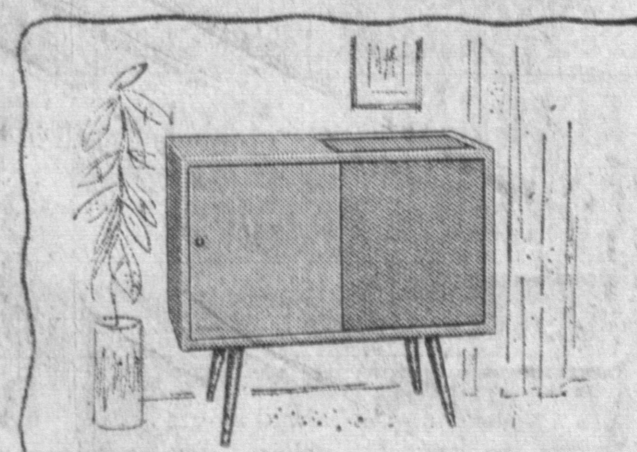
