Fund Raising Chairman Named by Hospital Group

Selection of Mrs. G. F. (Alice) Quiros, of 711 S. Catalina ave., Redondo Beach, as volunteer campaign headquarters chairman for the Harbor Osteopathic hospital was announced yesterday by Glenn A. Wymore, president of the hospital group.

Mrs. Quiros, well known in club and civic circles in the South Bay area, has been active in fund drive work for many years.

She was identified with successful drives at the University of Southern California in which monies for the Dental Clinic building and other structures was raised under the auspices of the Department of Development of the University.

Mrs. Quiros will head a drive to raise approximately \$300,000 during the coming three and one half months. The money to be raised in the South Bay and Harbor areas, will provide one third of the cost of a new \$900,000 Bay-Harbor Osteopathic hospital.

Two thirds of the cost of the new building will be paid from State and Federal taxes. The Harbor Osteopathic Hospital Inc. was recently allocated \$504,882 from the Hill-Burton Fund, which is distributed by a special hospital committee of the State Department of Public Health under the direction of Gordon Cummings.

Acquisition of the fund is dependent upon the area raising one third of the cost of the new hospital.

A free clinic and other services will be offered by the proposed new hospital in accordance with requirements of the State Department of Public Health, President Wymore announced.

Establishment of a fund drive headquarters in the Lomita area is planned this week.

The ways and means committee, Seaside PTA, under the direction of Mrs. C. T. Reid, held a meeting recently to discuss plans for the Halloween carnival to be held on October 26.

Increase in Telephones Reported

Torrance telephone gains in the past ten years were revealed today by Pacific Telephone manager Dick Pyle.

He noted that in 1947 the Fairfax exchange recorded 3600 telephones. Today it is estimated that there are over 12,500 in the Fairfax portion of Torrance.

The number of telephone calls recorded per day in 1947 were listed at a little more than 13,000. A recent figure set it at nearer 60,000 calls per day.

Investment in telephone facilities the past decade ranged from \$452,000 in 1947 to nearly \$4 million today.

Pyle went on to say that the company's tax picture has jumped eleven times in the past ten years from a supposed high during 1946-47 of \$8,039 to over \$90,850 in 1956-57.
