Unitarians Will Hear Dr. Hull

"Can We Understand Ourselves?" is the topic of the sermon to be delivered by Dr. William F. Hull, clinical psychologist, Sunday, September 1, at the Pacific Unitarian Church society. Dr. Hull's sermon will stress the fact that we cannot know ourselves by ourselves, but that we need outside help. Dr. Hull is a clinical psychologist, having practiced in Torrance since 1948, and then moving his office to Hollywood Riviera, Redondo Beach, in 1955. He received a degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Colorado, with honors, and was a practicing engineer prior to entering the clinical psychology field. He received his degree in psychology at the Western Institute of Psycho Analysis prior to entering private practice. His practice includes both individual and group therapy. Dr. Hull has found tremendous success in the use of hypnosis in the treatment of psychological abnormalities. In addition to his professional activities, Dr. Hull is a member of the Walteria Klwanis; the executive officer of the Civil Air Patrol, Long Beach Group 7.

'Christ Jesus' Sermon for September 1

These comforting words of Jesus, assuring light and understanding to every man, are part of a Bible passage from John's Gospel (8:12). "I am the light of the world; he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life." "Christ Jesus" is the subject of the Lesson-Sermon to be read in all Christian Science churches Sunday.

Correlating Jesus' statement Mary Baker Eddy writes in "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures." "The supremacy of Spirit was the foundation on which Jesus built. His sublime summary points to the religion of Love, Jesus established in the Christian era the precedent for all Christianity, theology and healing. Christians are under as direct orders now, as they were then, to be Christlike, to possess the Christ-spirit, to follow the Christ-example, and to heal the sick as well as the sinning." (P. 138).

Paul's admonition in Colossians (2:6, 7) is the Golden Text: "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him; rooted and built up in him, and established in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving."

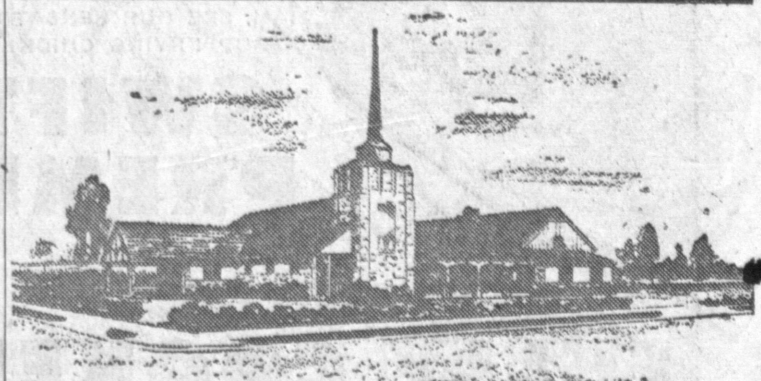

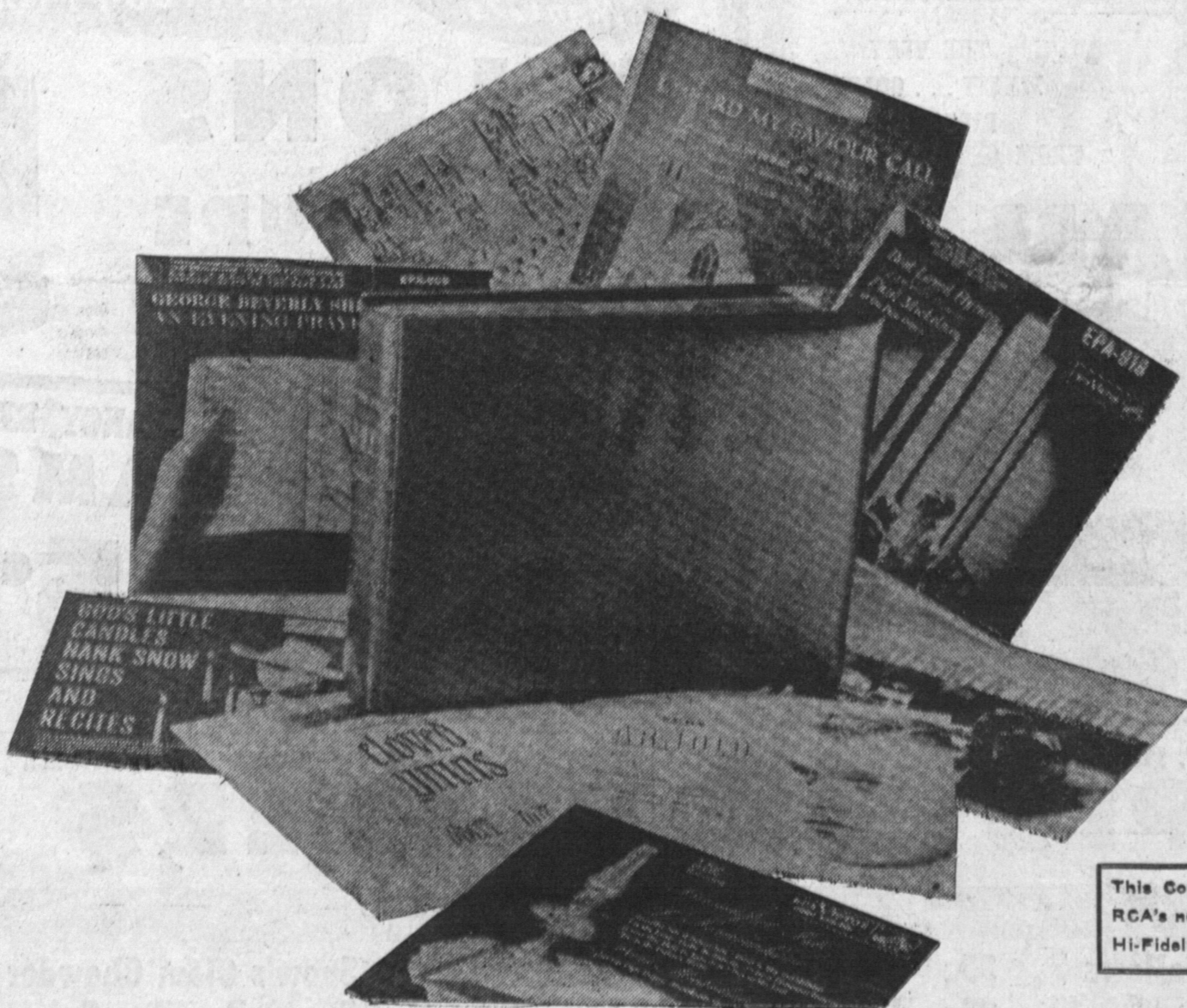
