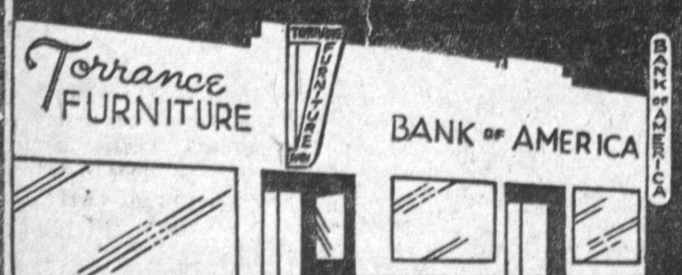

Evening Classes Offered

"Introduction to Teaching," a course designed both for those who have decided on teaching as a career and for those who wish to learn more about opportunities in this field, will be offered for the first time by the Harbor Evening College, according to Kenneth R. Need Women To Help With Fall Harvest

"Eddie" Walther, Manager of the Gardena Farm Labor office, located at 16407 S. New Hampshire ave., Gardena, says: "As the summer is coming to a close and fall is upon us, we are about to lose our youth, now employed in agriculture, to the classrooms. More workers will be needed in the fields to complete the late harvests of such crops as snap beans and cucumbers. Also such jobs as transplanting celery and cabbage and hoeing and weeding such crops that are already in. These are not high paying jobs but they are out in the open where one can feel the desire of being alive and working with nature." "At the present time there is a demand for women with experience to work in nurseries and with flowers. Transplanters, geranium strippers and aster dibblers should stop by our office and apply for work. In some instances women who work rapidly with their hands but who do not have experience learn quickly and earn good money." "Transportation is necessary on all jobs but sometimes rides can be arranged with other workers," Mrs. Walther said.
