DEAR EDITOR....

Reader Airs Her Views
Editor,
Torrance Press:

Have you ever wondered just what won us the "All-America City" award? Well, I have and I'm sure there are many others. After taking a look around, all I can see is that we are the fastest growing and the youngest community with an average age of 25.

There are many things lacking in Torrance and first in my opinion is our police department. We should have at least one officer per thousand people. With a population of approximately 92,000, we have about 80 people in our police force. That includes clerks and all. In our juvenile division we have five. That division alone needs many more. Having an average age of 25 can only mean we have many juvenile problems.

Torrance cannot be compared to other beach cities, as the nearest to us in population is Redondo Beach with around 45,000. In checking with the other beach cities, I find they have at least one officer per thousand. Most of them have more. Torrance can only be compared to cities the size of Burbank. Being about the same size as Torrance, it has a police force of well over 100.

Referring to the letter to the editor of the Press of August 15, berating the Sheriff's Department for allowing hot rodders to race around on the streets, I think that if the citizens would bother to look into the conditions of their police department they wouldn't be so fast to criticize them, but take the problem to the city hall where it belongs.

It seems that people have to have something happen to them personally before they wake up. I had an occasion to call the Torrance Police one night with no response, and I found you have to practically be put on a waiting list they are so short of men. Our very small department has over 20 square miles to cover, and a few men can't be everywhere.

Getting back to our youth problem, our teenagers have very little--our smaller children have even less--places to play. We in Southwest Park have the grounds for a park but, our (pardon the expression) City Council doesn't seem to have the money to develop it. We've paid taxes for three years now and have nothing, no parks, lights, or even bus service. Our many school gates in Torrance are kept locked while the children play in the streets. Maybe we are growing too fast.

Our teenagers have started a project themselves trying to get a club of some sort built where they can go and have some good clean fun. I hope everyone in Torrance will get behind them 100 per cent. They have gotten

off to a very good start by enlisting the aid of Mrs. Herma Tillim, who incidently, is one of three very capable people who resigned from our Parks and Recreation board in protest. Let's hope as private citizens they can accomplish more without the City Hall tying their hands.

Perhaps when we get a seven-man council and an elected mayor we'll get a few things done and maybe live up to our award. A city like everything else is what the people make it. Personally I don't think five men should run it all. If they'd spend as much time with our problems as they do fighting other departments, maybe they'd notice how badly we need a larger police force, a few parks, and who knows, maybe a street light or two.
