percentage points were gained over the 32 percent the city received last year at this time.

Torrance's inventory was graded against the average scores attained by the top 30 percent of cities of similar size which participate in the grading.

According to Watts, one factor which kept the city's grade down this year was the 14 dead and 398 injured on local streets throughout the year. He compared these figures to the average of 6 dead and 224 hurt.

The committee of ladies arranging the affair includes: Misses: James Van Hoven and Lewis Westood, co-chairmen.


