Top Bowlers Will Bowl In Torrance

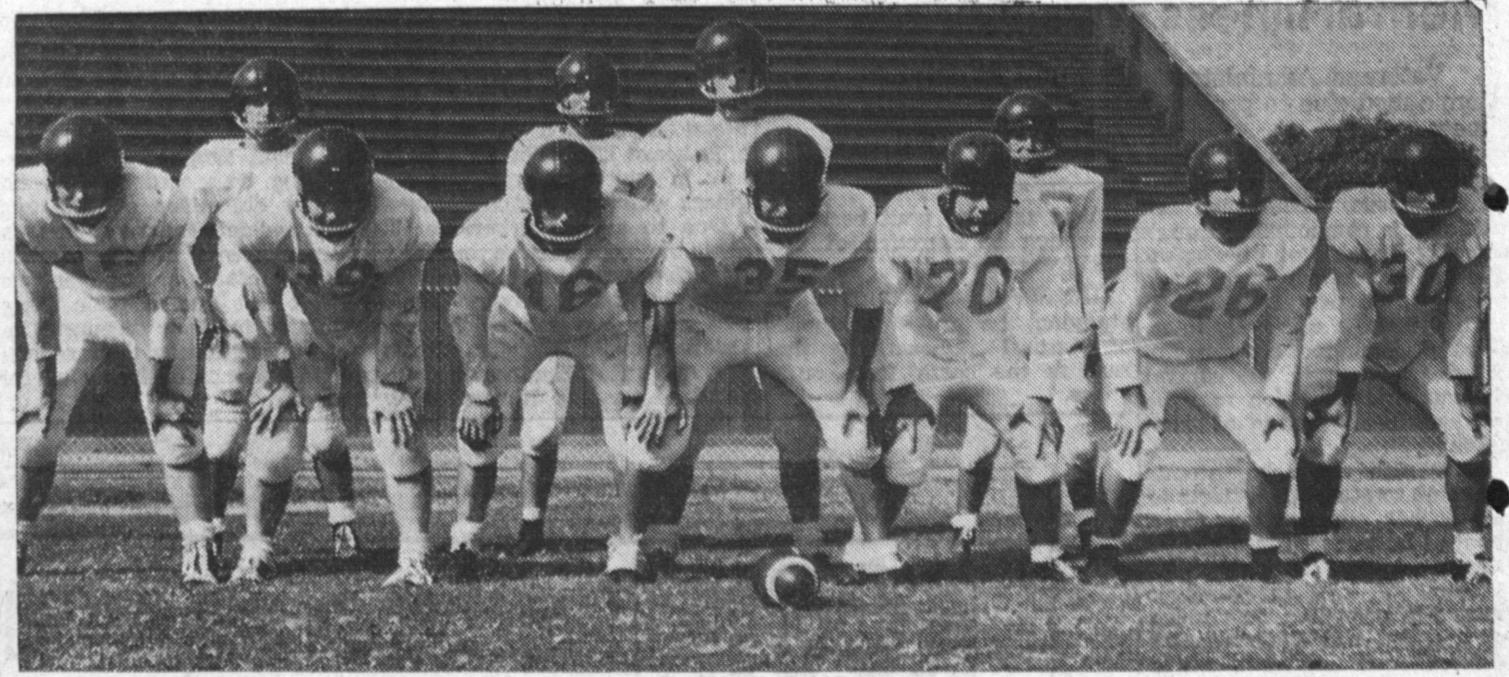

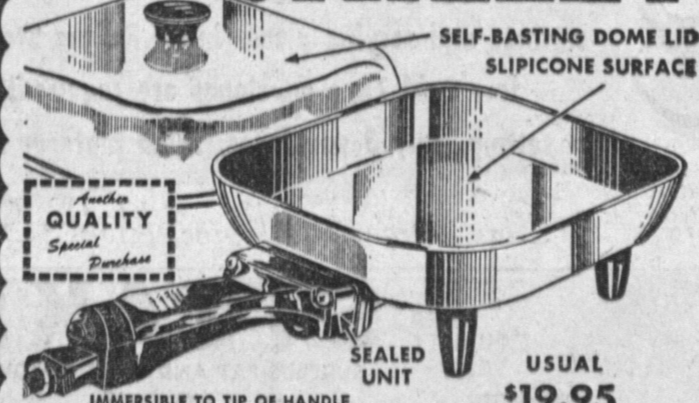

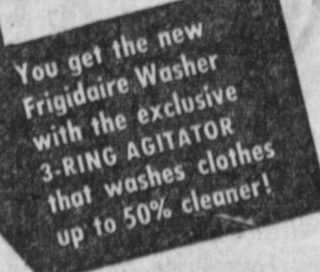

FOOTBALL ACTION SLATED

All seven Western State Conference football teams go into action this weekend, with five non-conference and one conference game on tap. Compton College will host Cerritos, newest WSC initiate, Saturday night in the opening game of the 1957 conference slate.

Four big tilts on tomorrow night will feature three games with the rival Metropolitan Conference. Ventura will meet the Metro's Santa Monica City College at Santa Monica, while highly ranked Pasadena, a top threat to upend Compton's domination of WSC football will be traveling to East Los Angeles. Glendale will be the only WSC team to host a Metro school, Los Angeles Valley, in their annual classic. Los Angeles City College will travel to San Francisco to meet City College there in one of the state's most important early season games.

Saturday night will see the Compton-Cerritos game and will also include the Pierce College-Santa Barbara game. Pierce's Brahmas were a 46-12 surprise victor over Palomar last weekend.
