## Vauxhall Not New In England

The Vauxhall, America's latest on the auto front, was introduced to the American market, September 27, 1957. But it is by no means a new car in the English automotive field.

### England Has Had Vauxhall

England has been producing this car at the Vauxhall plant (Pontiac G. M.) for several years. It is a car tried and tested for fine performance. Only the "Victor" among British production models, regardless of size or price, has yet appeared with the panoramic windshield. A first in the foreign car field.

The Vauxhall, General Motors entry into the fast growing foreign car market, features a 4 and 6 cylinder engine with a 35 MPG fuel consumption. The auto will be produced in the 4 door sedan model and station wagon in both 4 and 6 cylinder engine. It will be priced to sell from \$2100.00.

## New Phones For Smog Complaints

## New Driver License Law In Effect

An awful lot of good, experienced California drivers who otherwise would be entitled to quick renewal of their driver licenses for a full five years are having to run the full gamut of written and road tests to obtain three year licenses.

Why? Motor Vehicles Field Office Chief E. Keith Ball, "they have failed to observe the requirements of a new driver license law that went into effect September 11."

"The law, called variously the "birthday anniversary" and the "reward for good driving" act, stipulates that drivers who permit their licenses to lapse for more than 30 days must take a complete examination, including driving test, when applying for renewal.

And it further provides that unless application for renewal is made within 30 days after expiration of old licenses, the term of the new license shall be limited to three years. This, despite the fact that the driver might have had a perfect driving record, a circumstance which would have entitled him to a five year license, had he renewed within 30 days after his old license expired.

Ball disclosed that DMV field offices throughout the State report an unusually heavy volume of license renewals that require the giving of road tests to drivers who, had they applied before the 30 day expiration deadline, would have been entitled to new licenses merely upon passing the law and vision examinations.

"It is to the definite advantage of every driver to examine his license and apply for renewal within 30 days of the date it expires," the DMV official reminded.

"Drivers with good records who observe this timing requirement will receive renewed licenses good until the fifth date following the application date."

## Local Woman In National Bake Contest

Mrs. Anna Kendrick of 24240 Neece ave., and Mrs. Charles Colstad, 1 Figtree Road Portuguese Bend, today were named two of the 100 finalists in Pillsbury Mills' 9th Grand National Bake-Off Contest, to be held October 14-15 in Beverly Hills. This year for the first time the big baking event will be held in the New Beverly Hilton hotel; previous bake-offs were held in New York's Waldorf-Astoria.

Chosen on the basis of a recipe they submitted for contest judging earlier this year, Mrs. Kendrick and Colstad will compete with 98 women and girls from all parts of the country for over \$100,000 in cash and prizes. She will bake her prize recipe, along with other contestants, in the main ballroom of The Beverly Hilton hotel which will be turned into the world's largest kitchen for the Pillsbury Bake-Off event.

In addition to being eligible for the \$25,000 top prize and other awards, Mrs. Colstad and Mrs. Kendrick will receive an expense-paid stay at the Beverly Hilton and the General Electric range and mixer she uses during the contest.

Mrs. Kendrick and Mrs. Colstad learned of their good fortune today when Mr. Ray Kimrey, Pillsbury branch manager for this area, called to present them with a \$100 check and to arrange transportation and final plans for their stay at the Beverly Hilton hotel.

## Last Quarter Registration for Vehicles

Last quarter registration on commercial vehicles used seasonally in such operations as farming, logging and mining, will be due the first week of October.

State Motor Vehicles Director Paul Mason said there are some 20,000 such vehicles whose owners elect to pay their license, registration and weight fees on a quarterly basis for these periods when the vehicles are used.

The registration period for the last quarter of this year is between the dates of October 1 and October 7, inclusive. Application for registration should be made to any permanent office of the Department of Motor Vehicles, wherever feasible, rather than by mail, Mason said.

## Vet Widows May Get Benefits

An estimated 12,000 widows of veterans may be eligible for Veterans Administration benefits because of a recently enacted law liberalizing the definition of "widow."

Public Law 85-209 provided the change, VA said. Under the new law, the date of her marriage to the veteran will not disqualify a widow for VA benefits if a child was born of the marriage or, if no child was born, the marriage existed for at least five years.

Most laws providing for widows' benefits from VA contain a marriage cut-off date as an element of entitlement, with many different dates for varying benefits and periods of service.

The new law does not alter the existing cut-off dates, but provides uniform qualifying alternatives if the marriage dates are not met.
