

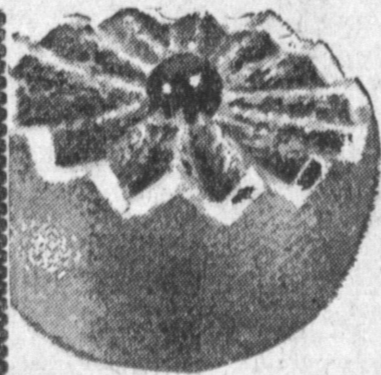

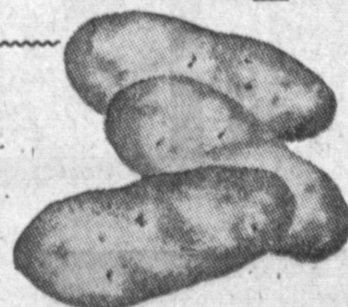

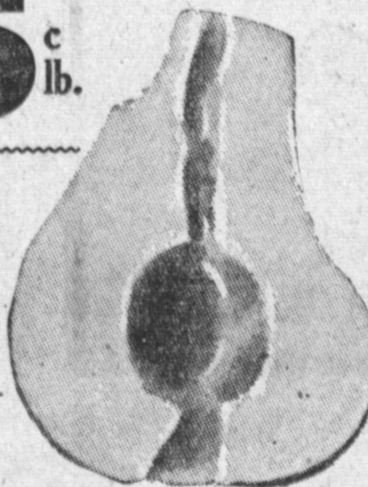

\$150,000 merchandise offered to public

Total of \$150,000 worth of brand new merchandise from Chicago and New York markets have arrived at Texder's in Gardena Valley Shopping center, on Redondo Beach boulevard between Vermont and Normandie avenues, according to Arthur Emery, owner. He said: "Residents of Gardena Valley will save up to 50 per cent below wholesale prices. Greatest values in the history of Texder's will be offered."

GAS RATES MAY RISE

Increased costs of natural gas from out-of-state sources may raise rates for Southern California including Torrance residents . . . subject to possible future refunds . . . according to applications filed today with the California Public Utilities Commission.

Southern California and Southern Counties Gas Companies each filed an application with the Commission today, requesting permission to collect higher rates to recover an annual increase of about 11 per cent in gas costs, which will be put into effect by their out-of-state supplier, El Paso Natural Gas Co., on January 1, 1958.

All classes of customers would be uniformly increased 2.15 cents per thousand cubic feet of gas. The effect on a typical residential user would be about 15 cents a month.

A spokesman for the two gas companies explained the increase will not bring additional net revenues to the companies, but is merely an offset collection, with the local firms passing the money on to El Paso Natural.

Final determination of the El Paso increase will be made by the Federal Power Commission after hearings to be held in Washington, D. C., at some later date. Thereafter, El Paso will be required to refund any disallowed amounts to the local companies, who will make corresponding refunds to their customers.

Planning for the new baby is the subject to be discussed at the first of the new expectant parents' classes starting Thursday, Oct. 3, in the Torrance Health center, 2300 Carson st., according to Dr. B. A. Kogan, District Health officer.

Educational material is offered to prospective mothers in the care of herself before the baby arrives and the care of the new infant, information given is educational in nature and does not in any way take the place of early and regular parental medical attention by physicians, the Health Officer said.

Subjects to be discussed include layette needs, health during pregnancy, nutrition, baby's growth, formula preparation, and baby bath technique. Motion pictures will also be shown at several of the sessions, Doctor Kogan said. The film, "Human Heredity" is scheduled for the first class.

The classes will be held every Thursday at 1 p.m., and prospective parents are invited. There is no registration or other fee as this is a tax-supported service of Los Angeles County Health dept.
