

Drivers who have novelties and other gadgets hanging between them and the car windshields are in violation of the law, says the California highway patrol.

"A new law passed by the 1957 legislature prohibits any person from driving a motor vehicle upon a highway with any object so placed in or upon the vehicle as to obstruct the driver's clear view through the windshield," declared Patrol Commissioner B. R. Caldwell. "This includes novelties such as dice, naby shoe, gadgets on strings or springs, and all such items.


