Nursery School Has Opening for Children

Announcement of a limited number of openings for pre-school children and parents in Coast Nursery school, a non-profit cooperative, was made today by Mrs. Eldon Nobles, membership chairman.

Classes for 2½ to kindergarten age children are held Tuesday through Friday from 9 to 12 noon. Mothers of the children participate as assistant teachers one morning each week, under the direction of Mrs. Azile Kokas, professional teacher-director of the group.

The cooperative is conducted under the auspices of the Adult Education Division of Torrance Unified School District.

Parents attend discussion and lecture meetings three evenings each month as part of the program, with emphasis on the development and problems of the pre-school child.

New location for the nursery school sessions is the South Bay Baptist church, 4565 Sharynne Lane in Torrance, with car pool arrangements for Hollywood Riviera members. The Fathers' Committee of the school is putting finishing touches on a new 3000 square foot play area for the children.

Formed three years ago, the non-sectarian group provides equipment and supervision for

group play, helping parents develop an awareness and understanding of their child's needs and growth.
