

TV Show Tries to Capture Rhythm, Emotion of Jazz

Jazz should be seen as well as heard. And producer Robert Herridge predicted today that its pictorial potentiality would be realized for the first time with "The Sound of Jazz" on CBS Television's "The Seven Lively Arts," Sunday, December 8 at 5 p.m.

Herridge based his forecast on the technique which "The Seven Lively Arts" has planned for presenting this jazz program. "I think," Herridge said, "that this will be the first television program on which jazz will be played purely for pleasure—not as an introduction to music, a lesson in art or a study of musical patterns.

"Our cameras and booms will take audiences 'inside' the group of musicians to capture the rhythm and emotions of the performers as well as of the music. This way the performance will be more exciting than if it were seen on a stage, in a theatre or night club."

Jazz, more than any other kind of music, lends itself to the close-ups of television, said Herridge. "It is perfect for the intimate home audience, because jazz is a very personal type of music. It is, simply, the personal experiences of individuals expressed in music."

Four phases in which the blues find expression — Dixieland, swing, modern and experimental — will be interpreted in "The Sound of Jazz," both in song and in instrumentation. The artists, who are among the music field's most celebrated, will include Billie Holiday, Louis Basie, Pee Wee Russell, Lester Young, Gerry Mulligan, Coleman Hawkins, Dickie Wells, Nat Pierce, Jimmy Guiffre, Jimmy Rushing and Roy Eldridge.

Although "The Sound of

Jazz" will originate "live" from New York, the telecast will not be presented before a studio audience. Said Herridge, "Jazz musicians are their own best audience. We will show their camera pick-ups of their expressions and their reactions during the performance. We will provide what we hope is the ideal atmosphere for uninhibited jazz performances — and we'll let the television audience come in close to see and hear these artists go at it. If we can show true jazz experts in truly creative moods, it will be worth raising the studio's ceiling!"

On the program the jazz stars also will tell briefly, in their own words, the meaning of this music to them and the stories behind their jazz careers.

The producer added, "People all over the country are aware that jazz currently has hit a new peak in popularity, but few outside the metropolitan centers actually know what all the shouting is about. Concluded Herridge, "We hope to correct this situation with 'The Sound of Jazz.'"

Le Gallienne To Appear On TV, Dec. 15

Eva Le Gallienne will make one of her rare television appearances when she stars as Elizabeth I in scenes from the play "Mary Stuart" on NBC-TV's "OmniBus," Sunday, December 15 at 4 p.m.

Miss Le Gallienne and Irene Worth, as Mary, Queen of Scots, will present scenes from the off-Broadway production of "Mary Stuart." The play, written by the German poet-playwright Friedrich Schiller, was first produced abroad in 1800 and was last seen in this country in 1900.

The play concerns Mary Stuart's final days of imprisonment in the Tower of London. The actress found two sources of conflict: First, Elizabeth's attempt to dispose of Mary's grand ideas!
