S. Steel's Columbia-Geneva Steel Division for its outstanding safety record. The plaque represents the National Safety Council's highest award.

U. S. Steel Mill in Torrance Wins 3rd National Safety Council Trophy

Another Award of Honor, the National Safety Council's highest recognition in industrial safety, graced the trophy room at the Torrance works of U. S. Steel's Columbia-Geneva Steel division this week.

The Torrance Works' latest Award of Honor was presented for completing 3,000,386 man hours without a disabling injury between January 9, 1956, and August 29, 1957.

This record, according to Kaplan, compares with a national average of 3.83 disabling injuries per million man hours worked in American industry as a whole.

The Award of Honor plaque signifies the second major safety honor the Torrance Works has received in as many weeks, having recently tied for first place with an eastern mill in the steel plant category for having operated without a disabling injury between July 1, 1956, and June 30, 1957. Forty-eight steel plants participated in the competition.

Kaplan also cited the plant's record in the Greater Los Angeles Safety Council's annual business and industry safety contest in which the Torrance Works has placed first each year in steel mill safety judging since this category was established in 1953.

Others participating in the ceremony were Don Lasell, general superintendent, of 105 Via Alameda, Palos Verdes Estates; E. J. Ahlstrom, supervisor of safety, of 729 West 123rd st., Los Angeles, and Don Hyde, superintendent of industrial relations, of 1537 El Prado ave., Torrance.

Pointing out that the Torrance Works had previously received Awards of Honor for outstanding safety records in 1951 and 1952, Kaplan said statistics show that steel workers today are safer on the job than away from work.

Place Dentures Immediately After Extraction

"What is an immediate denture?"—asks Mrs. L. R. of Harbor City.

"An immediate denture is one where the remaining natural teeth are removed and the denture is placed directly in the mouth, so the patient does not have to go without teeth.

Usually the front teeth are left. Then when the denture is ready, these are extracted and the denture inserted.

As the gums heal, the denture will gradually loosen up and sore spots may develop as the denture continues to settle. If the denture becomes too loose, your dentist may recommend some form of adhesive to help you until the gums are completely healed.

The denture can then be refitted, or in cases where the change is so great that the bite has changed, the dentures may have to be remade.
