Alondra Park To Feature Tots Play Area

One of the finest childrens' playgrounds in Los Angeles County is now under construction at Alondra park and will be ready for use next spring, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn reported this week.

The new playground area is included in a major improvement program on the Redondo Beach side of the park, which also will result in the construction of a new bathhouse for the swimming pool, increasing parking, landscaping and park lighting.

A large triangular area southwest of the swimming pool has been designated as the ocation of the playground area. The sides of the triangle are approximately 300 feet in lenth. Supervisor Hahn said that the play area will be fenced off and paved with premix asphalt which will be covered with a colored mastic compound.
