Retired veterans now may qualify for medical care from Veterans Administration on the same basis as discharged veterans, VA said today.

L. C. Chapman, manager 📢 the Los Angeles VA Regional Office, said this means certain veterans retired from the armed forces no longer need waive any of their retirement pay and elect to take disability compensation in order to receive VA medical or domiciliary care.


