King's Car Club of Torrance is sponsoring a Custom Car show and a Reliability and Poker run on Saturday, February 22, at the South Bay Shopping Center, 174th street and Hawthorne blvd. This is the first car show the club has sponsored. The Custom Car show will be held between 8:30 a.m. and 12 noon. In Sections A and B. So. Bay Shopping Center parking lot and the Reliability and Poker run will take place between 1 p.m. and 3 p.m.

Trophies will be awarded to the winners and car clubs attending the meet. A four foot trophy will be given for the car club having the most members present. The mayor's trophy, sponsored by Mayor Albert Isen of Torrance, will be awarded for first place in the Reliability run. A door prize will also be given away.

A reliability run may be from 20 to 200 to 300 miles long. Before the official run, the course is driven by two police officers. The time it takes them to drive the course is sealed in an envelope to be used later to judge the drivers in the official contest. The cars are started at 15 minute intervals. They must stop at all check points, must obey all speed limits, hospital zones, school zones, and must observe all traffic signals and signs. The driver who comes closest to the time made by the police officers is the winner.

As for the poker run, at each check point the drivers pick up one playing card. The driver holding the best poker hand at the end of the reliability run is the winner of the poker run.

All proceeds from the Custom Car show and the Reliability run will be donated to the Harbor District Mental Health Clinic. For two years the Mental Health Clinic has been chosen by the King's Car club to be the recipient of their funds. Last year the club donated \$150
