## PROPER TREATMENT OF **PYORRHEA**

"I have bad pyorrhea. What can be done for this?" asks Mrs. P. L. F. of Torrance.

Pyorrhea can be detrimental to the health of the patient. In addition it can have bad effects exienically as well as socially.
