While the majority of the applications have come from ources outside the local district, a number of applicants have come from current members of the college staff. President Murdock would not comment upon the question of whether the new appointment would be made from within or outside of the college.

El Camino, located on the 90 acre campus on Crenshaw blvd. between Manhattan Beach and Redondo Beach blyds., is now in its eleventh year with a present enrollment of over 9500. Only Superintendent

President Murdock is the only man to hold the superintendent's position; he, along with mempers of the original college staff, was instrumental in surveying the area to determine the need and prospective growth of a mmunity college

From an original staff of 30 the college faculty and administrative staff has grown to num. er over 200.

Under President Murdock's guidance, the college has been developed on a unique "pay-asyou-go" plan for capital outlay No bond issue has ever been requested by the college board, all existing buildings being debt-

Of the three directors originally serving in key administrative posts with President Mur dock, only one, Carl G. Arfwedson, director of business, remains in his original position. Arfwedson is not, a candidate for the president's office, President Murdock indicated.





