Channel Bids Due in May to Aid Drainage

Preparation of plans for the permanent improvement of Dominguez channel between Denker ave. and Grammercy pl., is nearing completion and the project is tentatively scheduled to be advertised for bids in May. Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced today.

This project is the second in a series designed to widen and despen the flood control channel up-stream from Vermont mont ave. to provide good drainage for the Centinela Valley.

In preparation for the permanent improvements, which will line the channel with reinforced concrete sides and bottom, the State Highway Department is now constructing a new bridge over the channel at Artesia blvd., between Western ave. and Gram-

Construction of the first unit, between Vermont ave. and Denker, was completed and accepted in February.

Supervisor Hahn has urged that all improvements planned for Dominguez channel be expedited to give relief to the Centinela Valley, which was hard hit by the recent storm.

As a result, construction of the third unit, between Grammercy and Redondo Beach blvd., is now being planned to go to contract next year.

The improvement between Denker and Grammercy will inclide a new bridge over the channel at Grammercy. Construction of the third section will include new bridges at Arlington ave., Crenshaw blvd. and Redondo Beach blvd.

Supervisor Hahn pointed out the culverts under these streets now are in adequate to carry the heavy flow of water in the channel during storms. As a result, debris jams up against the culverts and causes the water to back up and overflow the channel banks.

Plans for all improvements to the channel call for widening the banks to 75 feet, with construction of concrete sides 18 feet
