

25-34 Age Group Most Dangerous Drivers, Claim

Of all drivers involved in traffic accidents in California the greatest number are between the ages of 25 and 34 according to records kept by the California Highway Patrol.

"Each year about one-fourth of all the drivers involved in traffic accidents in this State are between 25 and 34 years of age,"

declared Patrol Commissioner B. R. Caldwell. "The 15 to 24 year age group run a close second with just under 24% of the total drivers involved."

"Approximately the same ratio holds true in analyzing the drivers in fatal accidents," Caldwell stated. "The 25 to 34 year age group made up 26% of the

total drivers involved in fatal accidents while the 15 to 24 year age group made up 24% of the total involved."

"A composite of the records indicates that a man between the ages of 25 and 34 driving too fast for conditions or violating a right-of-way is most apt to become involved in a fatal or

injury traffic accident between 4 and 5 p.m. on a city street," he continued. "The man will be driving a passenger car on a Saturday or Sunday in clear weather on dry pavement."

"He will have at least 11 years driving experience and be driving in an area not controlled by signs or signals," he said.

the same manner, each paying his or her own way.

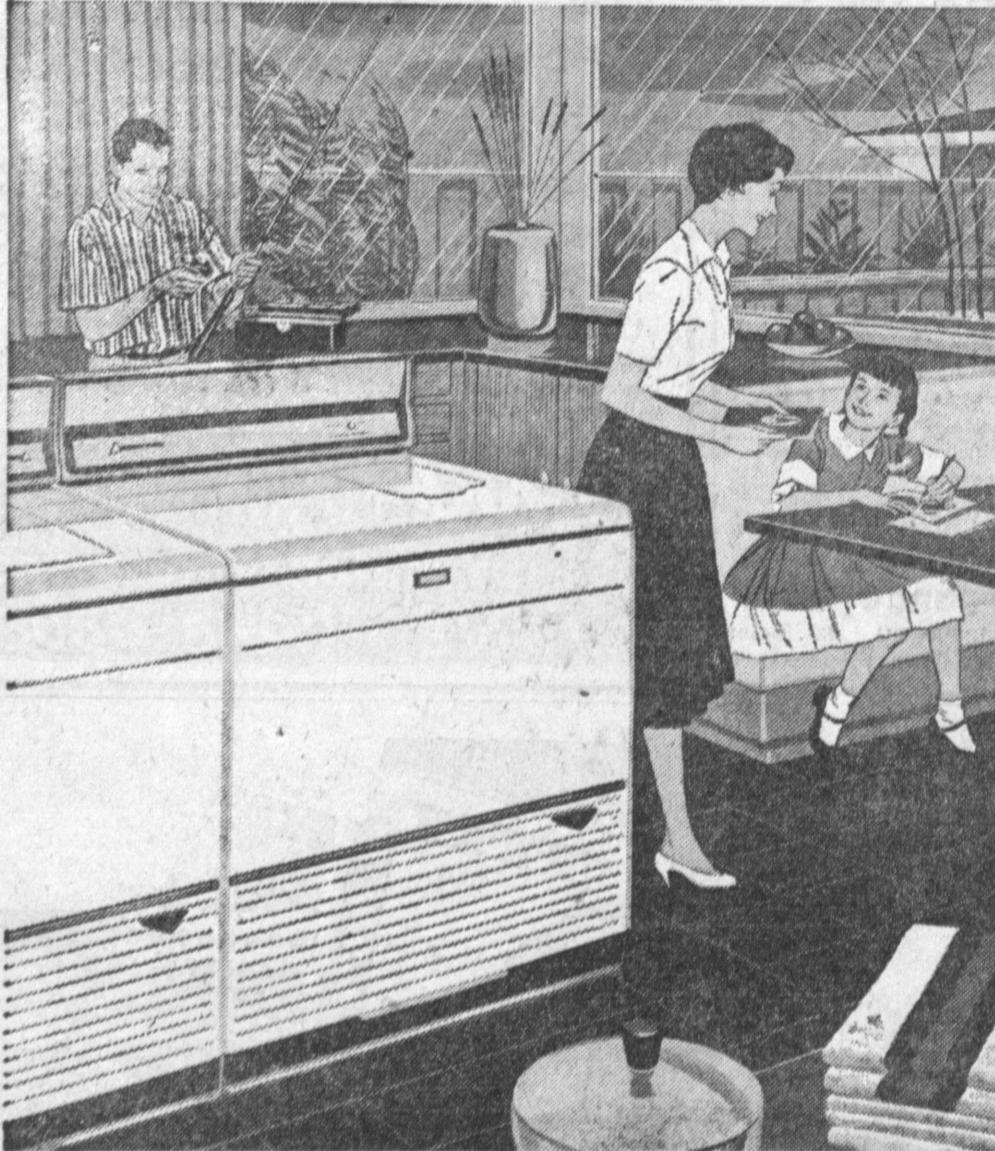
