### Doctor to Speak On Mental Ails At Chamber Group

Dr. A. L. Alesen, past president of the California Medical Association, will be the featured speaker at the monthly membership breakfast of the Torrance Chamber of Commerce at 7:30 a.m. on Tuesday, May 20, at the YWCA.

Co-chairman Dr. Rodney Stetson and Keith Border, said Dr. Alesen's speech will be titled "Mental Robots" which deals with the pitfalls and dangers of the mental health program.
