Marilyn Johnston, Waddell Sherman and Susan Dobrick performed dance numbers.

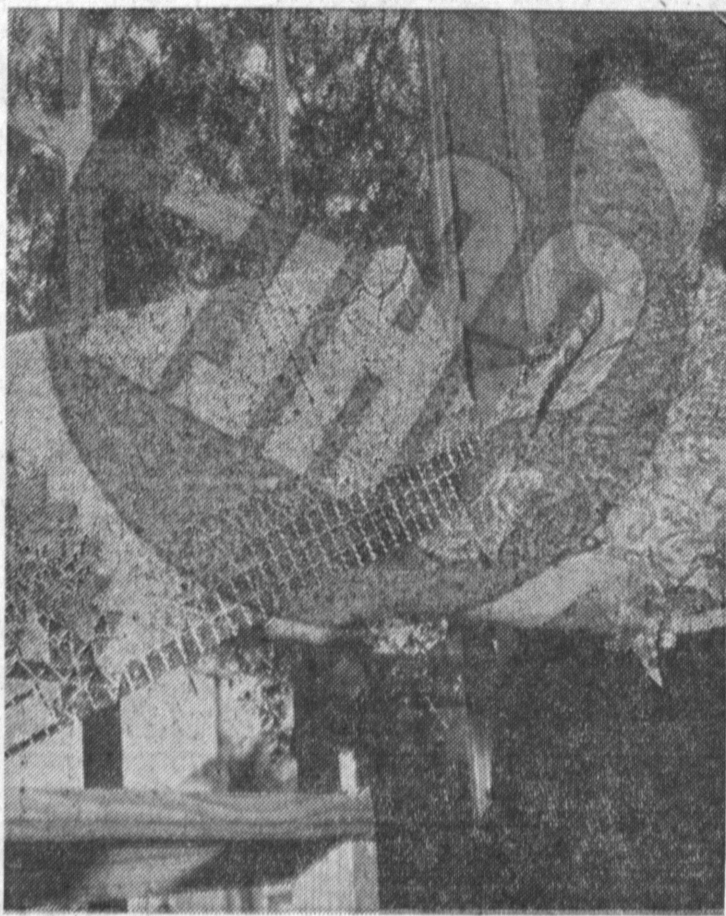

Mary Hospital Construction Runs On Schedule, Supervisor Announced

Construction of the Little Company of Mary Hospital is running on schedule according to G. A. Leverenz, construction supervisor.

Leverenz stated that the concrete has been poured for the entire first floor of the hospital. Forms for the second floor are progressing rapidly, and the concrete for this floor is scheduled to be poured by July 4.

The structure will be five stories high and will provide 146 beds plus about 30 bassinets. Completion is scheduled for the summer of 1959.

Most up-to-date service and equipment will be provided in all departments of the new hospital located on Torrance blvd., just west of Hawthorne blvd., in Torrance.

The emergency department

will be operated on a 24-hour basis. Plans also call for surgical, medical, obstetrical, pediatric, X-ray, isotope, deep therapy, laboratory and physical therapy departments.

In addition to the main hospital building, the adjoining service building will contain the laundry department along with boilers for heating and sterilizing. This building is nearing

completion and equipment is now being installed.

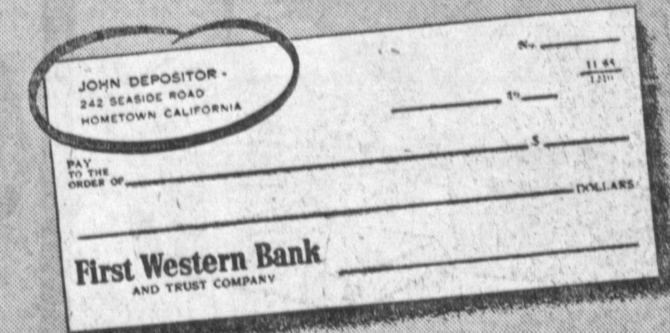
The hospital advisory committee held a luncheon meeting yesterday to discuss further plans to raise the amount needed to pay for the additional story to the west wing included in the contract.
