### College Physics Teacher to Host Television Show

Julius Sumner Miller, 5 foot, 5 1/2-inch, 152-pound human dynamo, is the shining light of the world's physics lecture circuit. Internationally renowned as a brilliant and dramatic speaker in physics, the El Camino College instructor's lectures always play to an SRO crowd. His current series at the University of California at Los Angeles was booked for a room accommodating 265 persons. Over 400 students and teachers showed up! This is the learned man whom the KNXT Public Affairs Department has secured to host its new 13-week physics series "Why Is

it So?" which premieres Sunday, June 15 (2:30 to 3 p.m.) on Channel 2. Miller attended Boston University where he obtained a bachelor of science degree in philosophy and mathematics in 1932, and an MA in theoretical physics in 1933. He graduated from the University of Idaho in 1940 with a master of science degree in engineering physics. He worked toward a doctorate at the University of Oklahoma in 1940-41, won a Carnegie Grant to study with Dr. Albert Einstein at the Institute for Advanced Studies in

1950 and was awarded a Ford Foundation Fellowship in 1952. As visiting professor, he has taught physics at the Ohio Wesleyan University and mathematics at the University of Alberta, Canada in 1951. He is one-time chairman of the department of physics at the Michigan College of Mining and Technology, and former president of the Southern California section of the American Association of Physics Teachers. His special fields are in electron configurations in the elements, and analytical mechanics. He is an

authority on demonstration experiments in physics and multiple-response test questions in physics. The scientist is author of numerous papers on demonstrations, the philosophy of demonstrations, the physics of toys and problems in analytical mechanics. His works have appeared in the American Journal of Physics, School Science and Mathematics, Scientific Monthly and many others. He boasts the largest collection of Albert-Einstein memorabilia, among them personally
