**Smog Boss Tells Better Conditions**

The Los Angeles public was a bit more clear-eyed and seeing a lot more of the surroundings these past few months than they have for a long time, according to a report issued today by the Air Pollution Control District on the frequency of eye irritation.

Air Pollution Control Officer Smith Griswold reported there were only 12 days of eye irritation at Civic Center in the first three months of this year, as compared with 18 during the same period in 1957.

At the same time he pointed out that there had been 47 days of low inversion (when smog hovered close to the ground) during January, February and March of this year, as compared to 57 days last year.

**Teacher Hiring Office to Open For Harbor Area**

A Harbor area employment office will be opened July 7 by the Los Angeles City Schools for local residents who wish to apply for teaching positions with the City School System, it was announced today by Associate Superintendent William B. Brown, head of the system's Personnel Division.

Opening of this office will give Harbor residents a convenience not previously available by providing a location for interviews, examinations and information—and thus saving a long trip or lengthy telephone calls to downtown employment centers," Brown stated.

The office is located on the grounds of Dominguez Elementary School, 21250 Santa Fe ave., Long Beach.

In the elementary school field, openings are available for persons who hold a California teacher's general elementary or kindergarten-primary credential. In addition, certain full time vacancies exist for persons who may receive a provisional position by holding a bachelor's degree and completing, before being assigned to a position, six units of professional education courses.

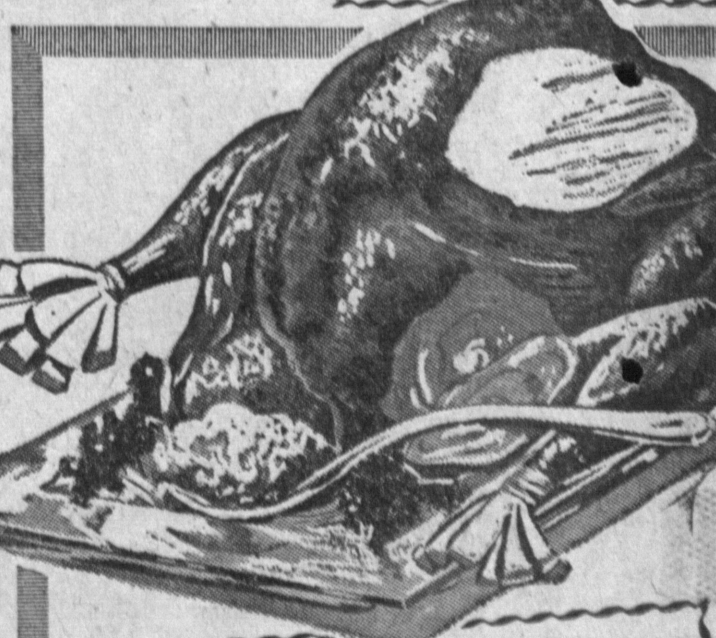
