Manager Advises of Advantages of **Bids and Pacts**

During times of rising prices, the city is better off negotiating agreements for goods and services, but if costs go up for no clearly defined reason, it is more advantageous to call for bids.

That was the report received by the City Council Tuesday from City Manager George Stevens.

In analyzing the cost to the city of negotiating and bidding on contracts, the officals noted that the city once saved a slice of money by calling for bids, and another time it increased costs considerably by seeking bids rather than negotiating a contract.

Stevens said that once the city saved itself nearly \$2500 by calling for bids rather than accepting a negotiated contract for liability insurance.

On the other hand, the city lost more than \$5000 by not accepting an automobile dealer's offer for renting police cars, and instead letting the contract out




