NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

ZONING CASE NO. 3439-(4) PROPOSED CHANGE OF OFFICIAL ZONING PLAN OF AVALON-SEPULVEDA COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES
Notice is hereby given that public hearing will be held by the Regional Planning Commission on the proposed amendment of Section 352 of Ordinance No. 14847, thereby making changes in the Official Zoning Plan of Avalon-Sepulveda, District No. 71 as established by Ordinance No. 5075 on February 24, 1948. Said hearing will be held on Tuesday, August 12, 1958 at 9:00 a. m. in Room 100, Los Angeles County Engineering Building, 108 West Second Street, Los Angeles. Testimony will be heard for and against said proposed amendment consisting of a change of zone from A-1 (Light Agriculture) to R-3 (Limited Multiple Residence) for 10 acres in two east rectangular parcels situated on the north side of 223rd Street on both sides of Grace Street with a frontage of 730 feet on 223rd Street and 310 feet on Grace Street respectively (all measurements are approximate) and such other changes of zone which the Commission may recommend in the interests of public health, safety and general welfare within the area described as follows: Lots 7, 8, and 9 of Tract 2982, M.B. 35-31, excluding therefrom any property zoned C-3 (Unlimited Commercial).

No City Help for Drainage

Councilmen cold-shouldered a request by the Chanslor-Western Oil and Development Co. to participate in the cost of drainage in an industrial tract at Maple and Maricopa. C. E. Doherty, vice president of the developers, said the flood control costs are estimated at \$165,000 and would help some adjacent residential areas. "I think it's their problem to take care of the drainage," said Councilman George Bradford.

Union Carbide Net Profit Up

Net income of Union Carbide for the second quarter of 1958 increased 18 per cent to \$27,088,759, or \$9.0 a share, compared to \$22,832,616, or \$7.6 a share, for the first quarter of the year, it was announced by Morse G. Dial, President.
"Economics of operation effected during the first six months resulted in improved profit margins, although sales of \$294,827,509 in the second quarter were at approximately the same level as first-quarter sales of \$294,077,919," Dial said. "The monthly sales volume improved during May and June, after a slight downward trend during the first quarter. The outlook for the balance of the year is for continued improvement, particularly in alloys and electrodes, the product groups which have been the most seriously affected by the business decline."
Sales for the first six months of 1958 amounted to \$588,905,428.

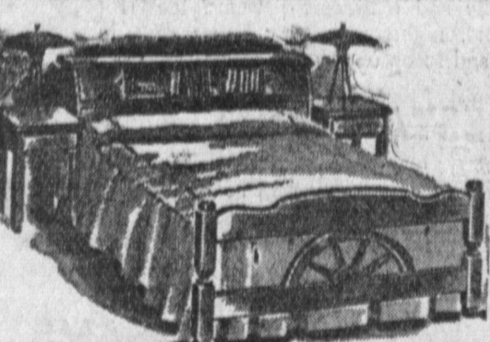
