### Bids Submitted on Alondra Work

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn reported that the apparent low bid for improvement of Prairie avenue and Manhattan Beach boulevard adjacent to Alondra park, has been submitted by the Construction Asphalt Sales Co., of Redondo Beach.

The eight bids received ranged from the apparent low of \$164,327 to a high of \$201,470.

Supervisor Hahn said that all bids are being checked and analyzed and it is expected that the contract for the work will be awarded within 30 days.

Work on the two streets are being done as a single project and will include the widening

and improving of the east side of Prairie avenue from Redondo Beach boulevard and Manhattan Beach, and the south side of Manhattan Beach boulevard between Prairie and the Dominguez channel. The project will include the construction of an additional traffic lane, paved shoulders, and curbs and gutters.
