

Registration Schedule for Students New to District Opens Here

A one-week registration for all students who will attend school for the first time in the Torrance Unified School District began Wednesday. Students enrolled here last year need not re-register.

Registration will be underway at both elementary and high schools from 9 a.m. to noon on Aug. 28, and 29 and Sept. 2 and 3. Classes will begin on Thursday, Sept. 11.

Elementary students will register at the principal's office in their school. Parents who do not know what school their child should attend may contact the Special Services Department of the schools at FA 8-8080.
