### Forms Available At Local Office

F. D. Fields, Navy recruiter located at 16422 South Vermont ave., Gardena, announced today that the 13th annual national competitive examinations for the regular Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps will be given to high school seniors and graduates Dec. 13. Application forms are now available and must be received before November 15, he added.

Designed to supplement the officer output of the Naval Academy, the NROTC program makes it possible for a young man to earn a regular commission while studying at the civilian college of his choice which has an NROTC unit. All tuition, fees and books are furnished by the Navy, and the student receives an annual retainer of \$600 for four years. During the summers the student goes on training cruises as a midshipman. After completing the usual four year college course, he is commissioned in the Regular Navy or Marine Corps and goes on active duty as a prospective career officer with the Navy's far flung fleets. For those who apply and qualify, immediate assignment to flight training will open new careers in Naval Aviation.

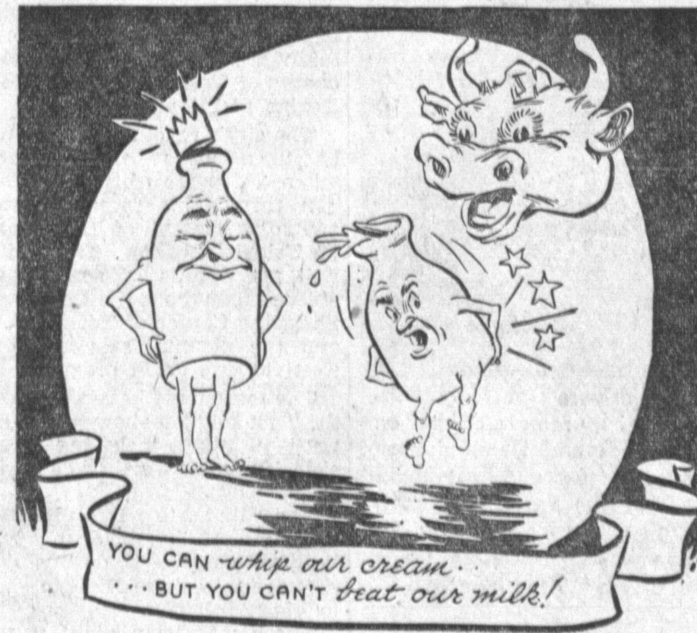

### EMERGENCY CALLS

An explosion—an auto accident—a robbery—a blazing house—at attempted suicide—perhaps murder.

Each one of these situations is an emergency, a real emergency. The police, the fire department, the sheriff's office, or an ambulance are required immediately.

The first question asked is—How can I get help? The answer is, the closest telephone and the number to dial is "116."

By dialing 116, the caller is assured of reaching an operator within a matter of seconds. She will help make a prompt connection to the emergency service you asked for—if your call is an emergency.

Be sure you give her sufficient information, such as—I want to report a "Fire," or I want a "Policeman," or I want an "Ambulance," or I want the "Sheriff," or "Highway Patrol." Then give the address and name of the city or town where the emergency exists.
