Although plagued very seriously by injuries, Bob Shoup, North High head football coach, is still satisfied with the progress of the team, as the opening game with Warren, Saturday, draws closer.

The most serious injury is Eugene Polson, a promising JV letterman guard, with a slipped disc. He will be out for the year. Center Paul Shaffer will be out for three weeks with a kidney injury. This forced Coach Shoup to convert 6' 5", 325-

pound John Bowman into the pivot slot.

#### Crompton Out

Bob Crompton, stellar linebacker and fullback will be out indefinitely, with a badly twisted knee. First string right end, and best receiver, Dennis Berry has missed 10 days of practice with a groin injury.

Following two hard scrimmage sessions, 14 players have been put on the inactive list.

The offensive unit for the Saxons showed a bright spark, as Chuck Webb showed he was

a breakaway threat by ripping off touchdowns runs of 99 and 88 yards.

#### Two Touchdowns

All CIF candidate Ernie "Big Train" Thomsen ran for two touchdowns with a swing pass for 95 yards and a run of 56 yards. The first team scored five times without losing the ball.

Downfield blocking for the Saxons has been hard and vicious, with Day Chadwick looking exceptionally good at the tackle slot.

Guards Dick Bybee, and Eddie Jauregui have been playing good ball, as have left end Steve Mearring, and tackle George Poutts. Dick Hedgecock and Bill Hall are improving at quarterback.
