Factory Job Rise Continues Here

California manufacturing employment increased to 1,236,900 wage and salary workers in August from 1,177,200 in July. This addition of 59,700 workers resulted as canning activity picked up sharply and defense-related industries expanded their payrolls, Edward P. Park, California Director of Industrial Relations, announced today.

Employment in the fruit and vegetable canning industry nearly doubled to 96,400 in August as the canning season approached its peak. Nearly all other manufacturing industry groups reported small gains.

Automobile assembly was the only industry reporting a significant employment reduction between July and August. About 900 workers were laid off as the 1959 model changeover got under way.

Hahn Asks Speed in Cutting Smog Causing Products

In introducing a motion instructing the Air Pollution Control District to assign the highest possible priority toward the development of a "clean" gasoline, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn declared today that "we are not winning the battle against smog fast enough."

"I felt that during the past week that smog was as bad as it ever was," he stated.

His motion, which was adopted by the Board of Supervisors, also called for stepped up research on the effects of the various methods of refining crude oil, including catalytic cracking, and immediate development of effective controls for butadiene plants and other similar chemical manufacturing sources of air pollution.
