**School Board
Takes Stand on
Ballot Measures**

The Torrance Board of Education went on record Tuesday night in favor of Proposition 2 and against Proposition 17 on the November ballot.

Proposition 2 would provide \$220,000,000 in state aid funds for use of school districts which need financial help in their building programs. To date, Torrance has received about \$5,000,000 in state aid for construction of local schools, and the board resolution strongly urged continuance of the program.

Proposition 17 would cut the sales tax and increase income tax rates.

In its resolution, the board pointed out that because schools derive their funds from general sales tax revenues, they stand to lose a considerable amount of support if the proposition passes. According to estimates, the district would lose \$50 million in sales tax revenues, although the 1957 legislature approved at \$37 million increase in expenditures for education.

"The Board strongly opposes the passage of Proposition 17 as an unsound measure which would seriously reduce the state's ability to provide an adequate level of financial support to the school districts of the state," the board resolution said.

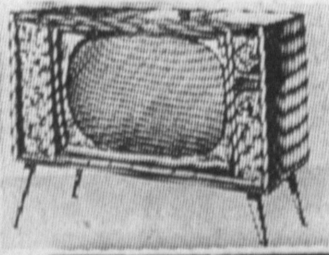

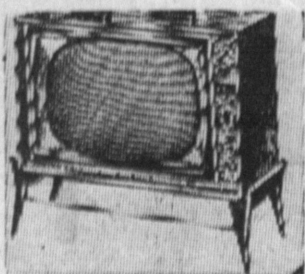

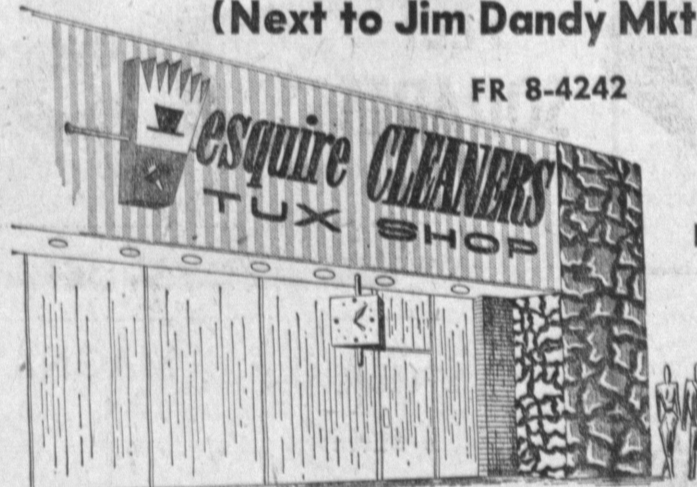
