Youth Safety Run To Start, End in Torrance

The 1959 Youth Safety Run—an annual contest of safe and economical driving—of Los Angeles County car clubs will start and end in Torrance next June, according to Police Chief Percy Bennett. The destination, again, will be Yosemite National Park.

The Safety Run is supervised by the Police Advisory Council for Car Clubs, Bennett stated.

The Council consists of at least one officer from each of the 29 police departments, plus a representative of the California Highway Patrol and the Los Angeles Sheriffs Department.

Torrance representatives on the Council are Officers A. L. Jackson and Sam Piazza, who have been acting as advisors to eight Torrance car clubs.

The Police Advisory Council has been the means of channeling "hot rodders" into safe and constructive activities, such as the Youth Safety Run.

In the five years the runs have been held, there has not been a single traffic accident involving a contesting car, Bennett pointed out. The rules of the safety run also require that no youth who has received a traffic citation in the previous six months may compete.

Each community in Los Angeles County with affiliated car clubs will be eligible to enter the Safety Run. Starting point of the run last June was Pomona, with 30 entries representing virtually every community in the county.

Pilot cars, manned by police officers, will lay out the 1959 course, making careful note of legal speed limits along the route. The time in which a contestant should safely complete the course is determined, and a car which comes in too quickly is penalized. Observers check the cars continually along the route, and the gasoline consumption is rigidly measured.
