Rubbish Law Referred for Further Study

An ordinance which would have made provisions for exemptions to paying the municipal rubbish charge, was shelved for further report. Councilman Nickolas O. Deale's motion not to grant any exemptions failed to gain support, after individual councilmen made several criticisms of the rubbish program. Councilman George Bradford said that the city is missing the most lucrative part of the rubbish business by confining itself to residential collections, while J. A. Bessley said that some residents who receive service have not been billed. The ordinance was referred for further study by City Manager George Stevens and City Attorney Stanley Remelmeier.

Students Prep for Yule Jobs

High school students in Torrance are getting salesmanship training this week to help them prepare for Christmas vacation jobs. Students who are interested, are attending after-school sessions at Torrance's three high schools. The course is required for students who are trying for Christmas jobs under the district's work experience program. The Torrance school board Tuesday night approved letting up to 400 students off a week early to work in local businesses during the Christmas season. Only students with satisfactory grade averages and qualifications will get jobs through the district program, although any student is eligible to take the after-school salesmanship course, according to Lysle Albro, coordinator. Many businesses in this area have been contacted and will hire students for Yuletide work, he said. The number is expected to be larger than 180 students who were placed last year, when the recession apparently cut down on extra help. In 1956, some 300 students held Christmas jobs.
