Teen-age boys and girls will spend Dec. 13-14 at YMCA Camp Round Meadow for a weekend of recreation and collecting mistletoe. The mistletoe will be sold at the Y's Men's Christmas Tree lot at Torrance Blvd. and Arlington from Dec. 11-21. All proceeds from the sale will be used for youth work at the Y.
