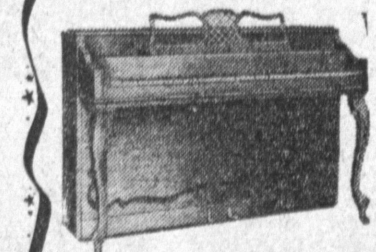

Ambulance Carrying Patient Involved in Traffic Crash

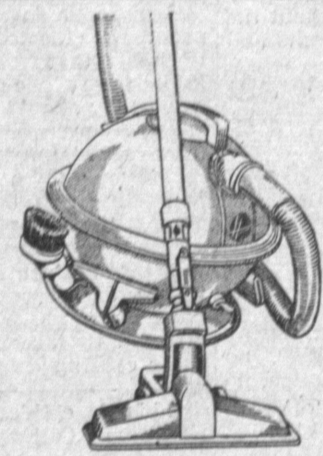

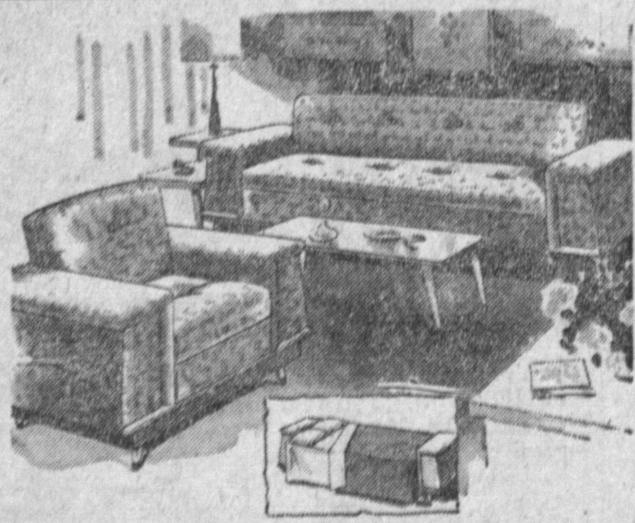
