"The advantages" of locally stored underground water are obvious in case of disaster," Hogue said. "Any break in the Colorado River Aqueduct which crosses the San Andreas earthquake fault could cause a water famine here unles we build up our underground storage."

The proposed Replenishment District covers the entire southern portion of ols Angeles County below Whittier Narrows, Montebello Hills, Santa Barbara Ave. in Los Angeles and the Baldwin Hills. It reaches from the Orange County line to the ocean.

Construction Dips From High Mark of January, 1958
