Planners to Mull Plans for Four Major Flood Control Projects for Torrance

Locations of four major storm drain projects in Torrance and an alternate if there are sufficient funds, was submitted to the Planning Commission this week.

The four flood control projects, part of the \$225,000,000 bond issue approved last year, will cost a total of \$2,589,600.

They will bring relief to Waleria Lake, Hollywood Riviera, North and East Torrance as well as the downtown area.

The supplementary job will cost \$525,200, and will only be constructed if sufficient money is left over after the others have been completed.

Acting City Engineer Ronald W. Bishop will be in charge of preparing the plans for the projects to speed actual construction under jurisdiction of the County Flood Control District.

The projects include the following:

No. 584—A retention basin of 25 acres to drain Waleria Lake. Cost is estimated at \$920,400. It will be located northwesterly of Hawthorne Blvd. and 236th St., and will connect with an existing drain at Madison Ave. A pump station will be provided.

No. 585—This project is estimated to cost \$364,000 and is designed to relieve the Hollywood area both in Torrance and Redondo Beach. Another portion

of the project will be constructed south of Pacific Coast Highway in the vicinity of Madison St.

No. 586—Cost of this project is estimated at \$488,800, and will run along Glenburn Ave. from 174th to 182nd St., and west on 182nd St. to Prairie Ave.

Another section of it will run southerly on Crenshaw Blvd., then southwesterly to Elgar Ave. and 188th St., then southerly to 170th St. Another branch of this project will run in Torrance Blvd. from Engracia to Madrid.

No. 587—Costing \$813,400, this project begins at Del Amo Blvd. near Arlington Ave., on Arlington to 190th St. to Crenshaw Blvd. and then northeasterly to 188th St. Another phase will begin at Western Ave., south of Torrance Blvd., westerly to an existing earth channel.

No. 741—The supplementary project begins at Dominguez Ave. and Crenshaw Blvd., south to Maricopa St., west to Maple Ave. to Sonoma St., west to Florwood Ave.
